PRACTICAL INFORMATION

➤ *How to reach Trento by plane*

VERONA: The closest airport to Trento is the **Verona** Valerio Catullo Villafranca Airport (90 km distance). There is a frequent bus connection between the Airport and the city's main railway station "Verona Porta Nuova" from 6:10 am to 23:10 pm (Prices are ca. 4, 50 € for a one-way trip).

From Verona city you can reach Trento within 1 hour by train. There are trains each 40 minutes (<http://www.trenitalia.it>).

VENICE: Venice's airport is 217 km away from Trento and can be reached by public transport. The airport is connected to the nearby railway stations of Mestre-Venice and Venice-Santa Lucia by scheduled bus services.

MILAN: There are two Airports: Linate and Malpensa (<http://www.sea-aeroportimilano.it>). Public transports to the central train station operate from 05:40 am to 21:35 pm.

From Linate you reach the central train station by bus in around 20 minutes, whereas it takes you around 50 minutes by bus from Malpensa. There is a train connection from Malpensa airport that brings you to Milano Nord station in 45 minutes

From Milan city you can reach Trento within maximum 3 hour by train. There are trains each 2 hours (<http://www.trenitalia.it>).

MUNICH, GERMANY: The airport "Franz Joseph Strauss" in Munich is 330 km away from Trento. However, it can be reached within 4 hours as there are frequent train connections.
