

## Implementing the Anti-Corruption Action Plan for Asia-Pacific: Reforms and anti-corruption resources Thailand

Thailand joined the ADB/OECD Anti-Corruption Initiative for Asia-Pacific on 18 April 2005 ([▶ endorsement statement](#)) and is represented in the Initiative's Steering Group through the Ministry of Justice.

### Anti-Corruption reform in the framework of the Action Plan

Thailand's current priority for reform under the Anti-Corruption Action Plan is to [raise and strengthen the public awareness about corruption and to build up a wide and strong countrywide network](#).

Thailand's reform progress is documented in the regular reports that the country delivered at the Steering Group meetings ([▶ reform progress](#)). The region-wide report on [Anti-Corruption Policies in Asia-Pacific](#) provides a horizontal overview of Thailand's policies, institutions and frameworks as well as progress in this area as of the first quarter of 2006. The outcome of the Initiative's Thematic Reviews provides more detailed analysis of mechanisms to [curb corruption in public procurement](#) and the instruments in place to seek and provide [mutual legal assistance, extradition and the recovery of proceeds of corruption](#).
