Technical Cooperation in Chile.

From recipient to provider:

- Reinventing AgCI (Agencia de Cooperación Internacional de Chile): from coordination of donor contributions after return to democracy to development of a strategic partnerships to provide TC in LAC.
- Maximizing effect of a modest budget (US\$ 3.8 million in '08, 800,000 for trade related issues), plus in-kind contributions.
- Objectives and priorities.
- Modes of cooperation.
 - Triangular.
 - Horizontal.



Trade negotiating experience as result of on-the-ground training and “early-bird” effect:

- FTAs unintended consequence: negotiating expertise at time of increase in RTAs and BTAs.
- Chile begins drive for FTAs early: Mexico and Canada first teachers. Simultaneous negotiations with US and EU; first FTAs negotiating partners for S. Korea and China (Japan's first S. American partner); followed FTAs in L. America.
 - Examples
 - negotiations: advisory work with CAFTA-DR, Peru, Colombia negotiating teams, among others.
 - making agreements work - trade promotion, competitiveness challenges.



Cooperation Funds at IADB.

- "Learning from International Best Practices" Trust Fund-
 - Going beyond trade expansion, aiming for development.
 - Learning from countries with similar profile that not long ago faced development challenges and overcame them (Ireland, Finland, Spain, Portugal, South Korean, Australia, New Zealand).
- "Support Technological Innovation in Central America and DR" Trust Fund.
 - Attempt to share Chilean experience of institutions that promote innovation (CORFO and Fundación Chile).
 - Examples of projects and beneficiaries.



What role can South-South TC play.

Is there a role for South-South cooperation?

- Key (obvious) benefits:
 - Greater affinity to policy challenges, institutional struggles, cultural idiosyncrasies, and weight of tradition.
 - Good for foreign policy- fosters closer country ties and institutional networking.
 - Better distribution of regional responsibilities.



What Role can South-South TC play.

How to get there? TC bonds market?

- Create a system to register, track, and exchange “cooperation bonds”.
 - *Country A performs TA for Country P.*
 - *Regional entity registers that TA in the form of a CT bond.*
 - *Country A can “cash” its CT bond by requesting regional entity to help address policy issue/challenge.*
 - *Regional entity mobilizes contribution by Country Y to meet request, either by Trust Fund financing or by in-kind support.*
- Role for OECD and RDBs exploring feasibility and interest, and designing mechanism.
