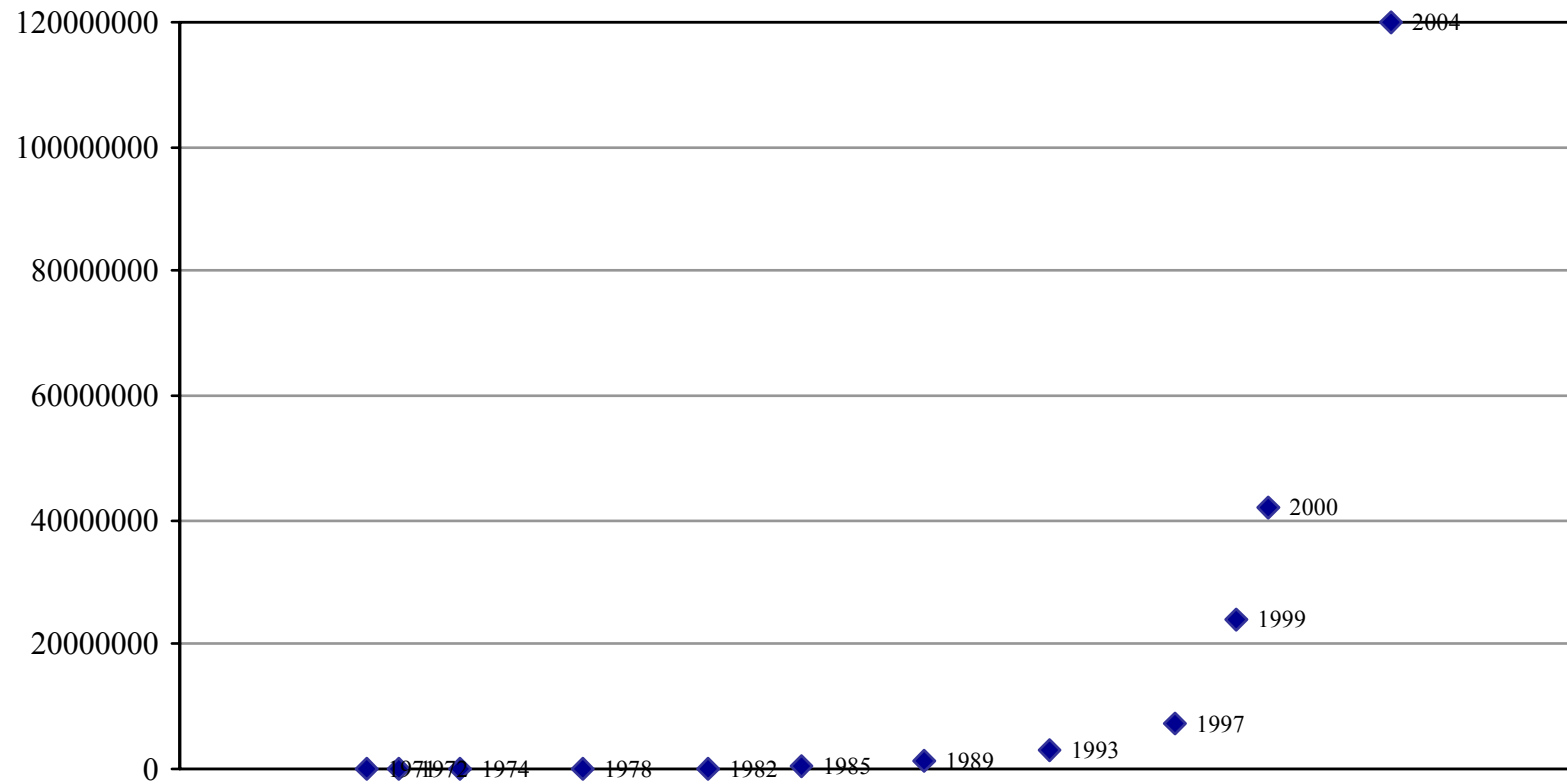

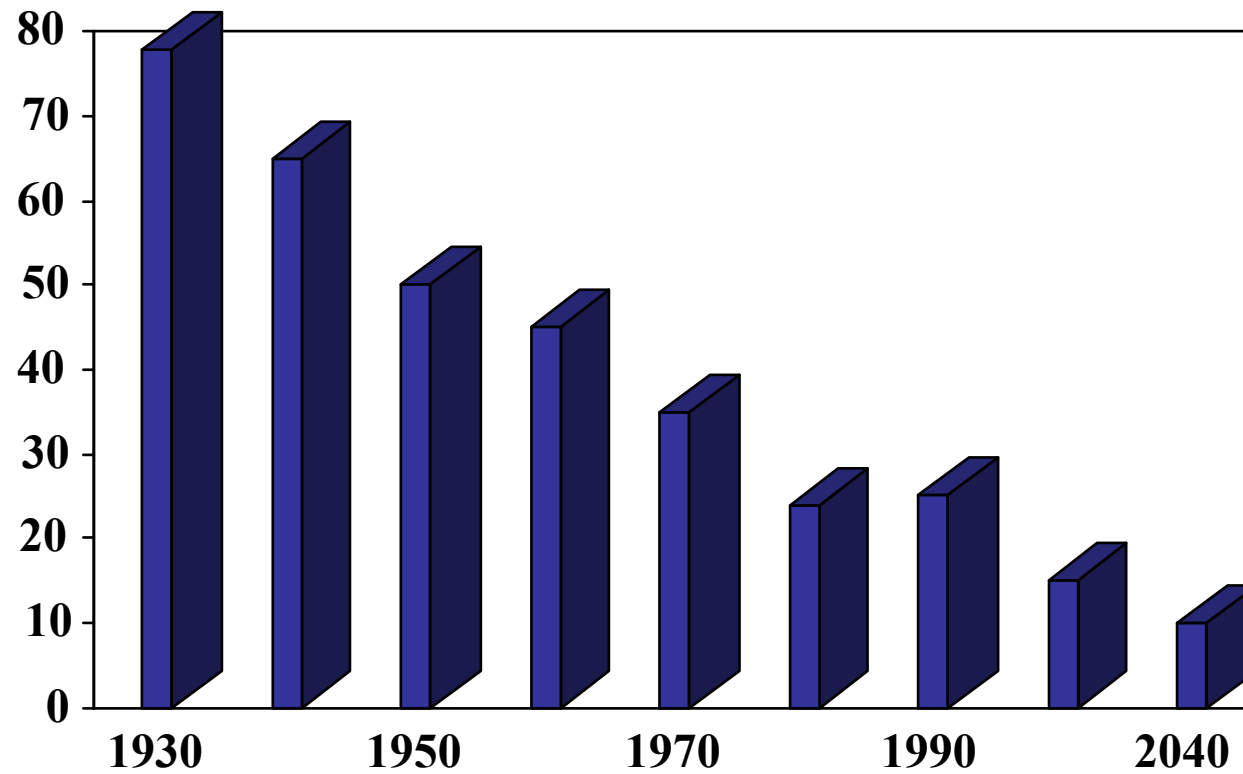

What Moore's Law Really Looks Like

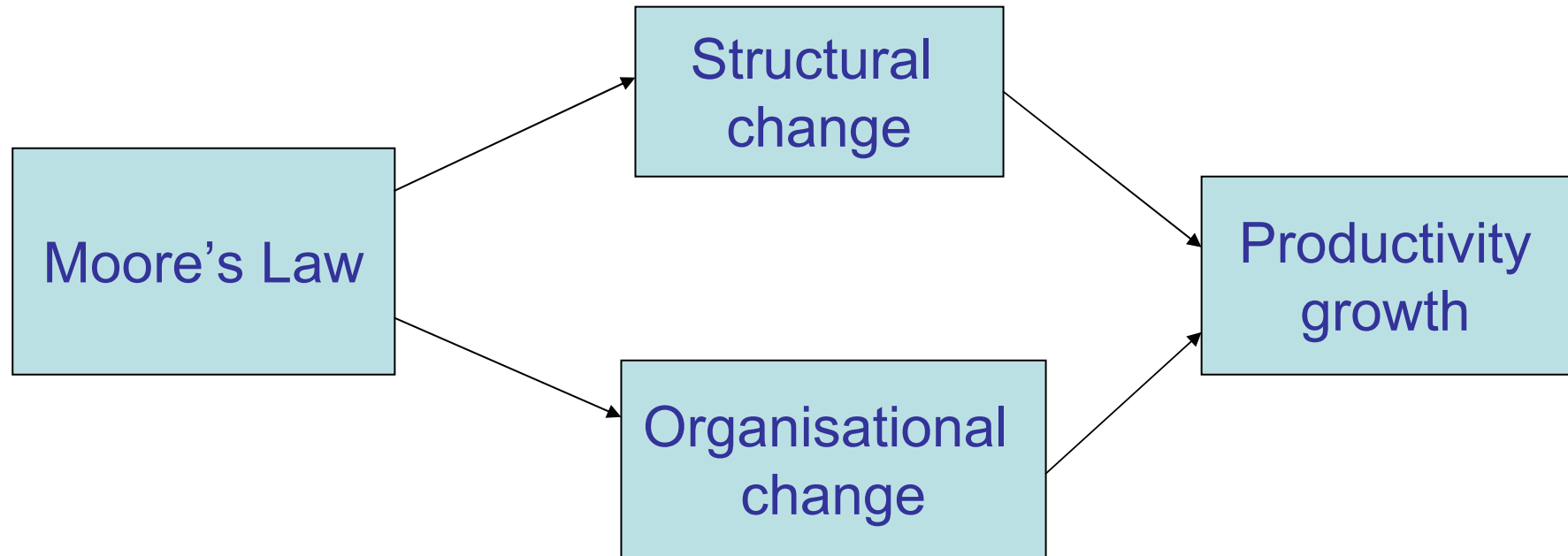
Number of transistors per integrated circuit, 1965-2004, Intel



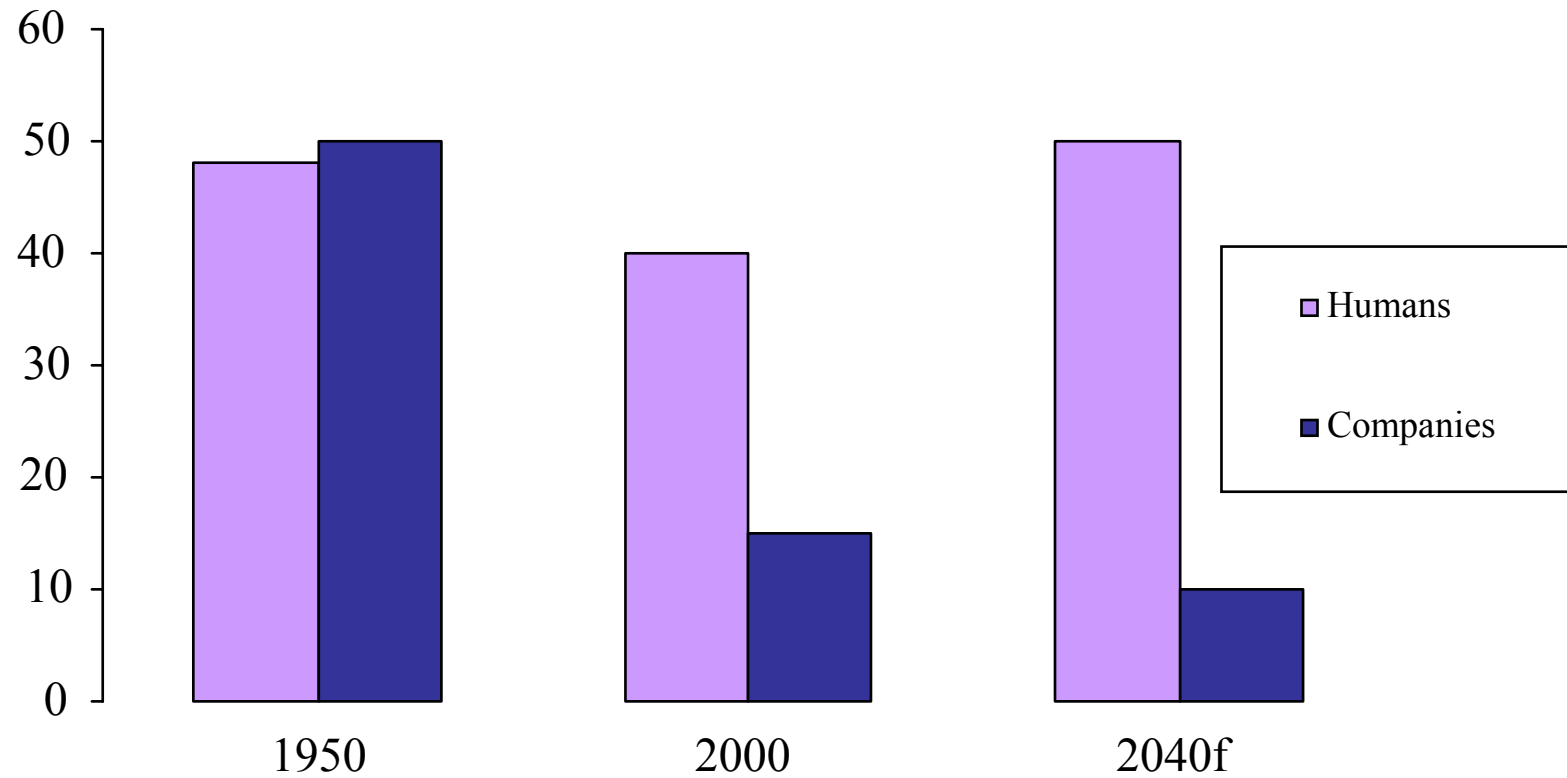
Average life of large listed companies

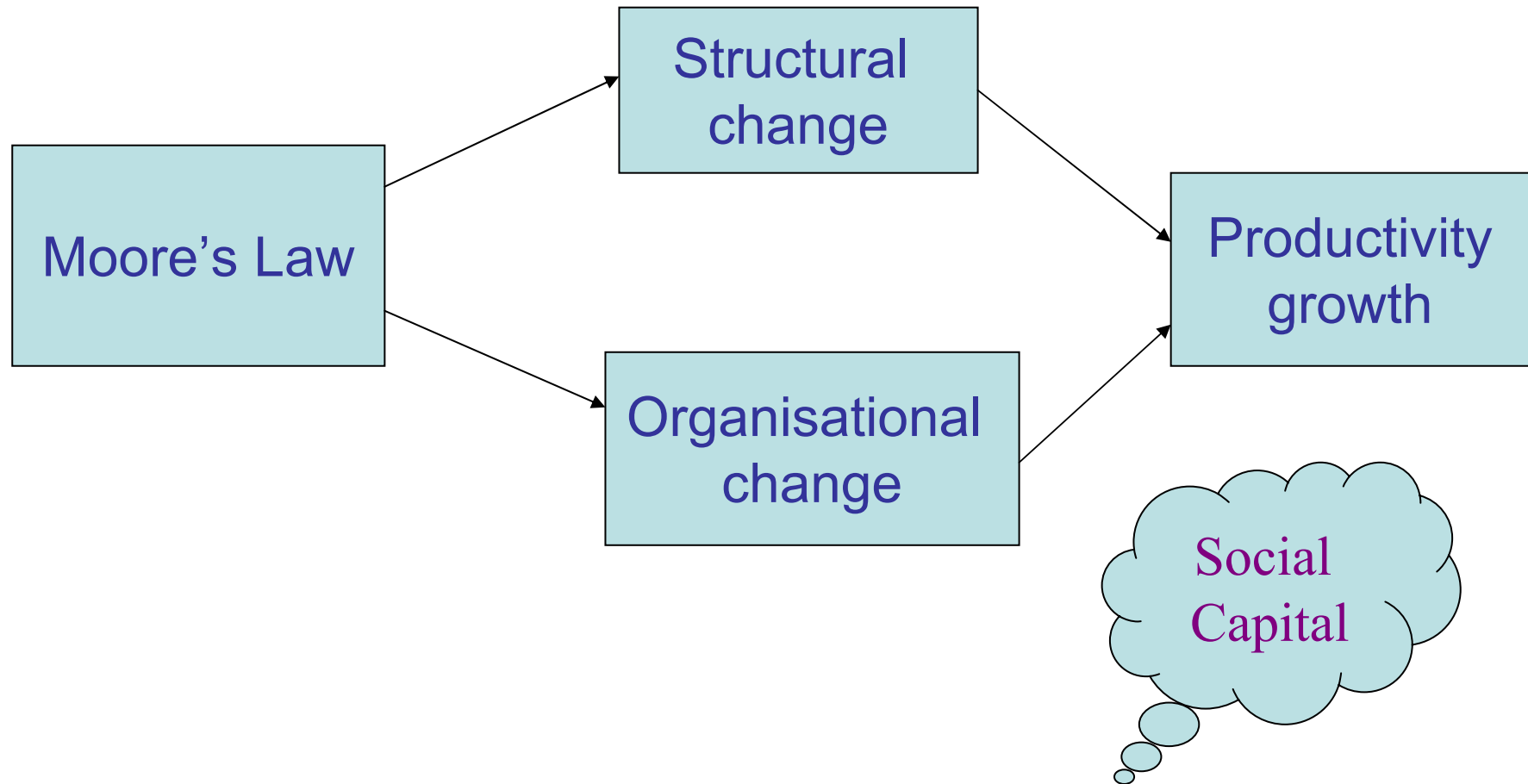
