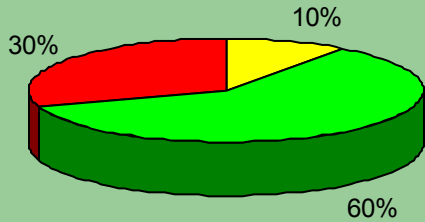
# NEDA Objectives

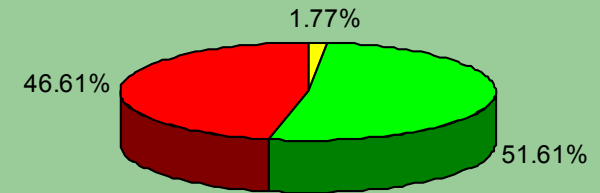

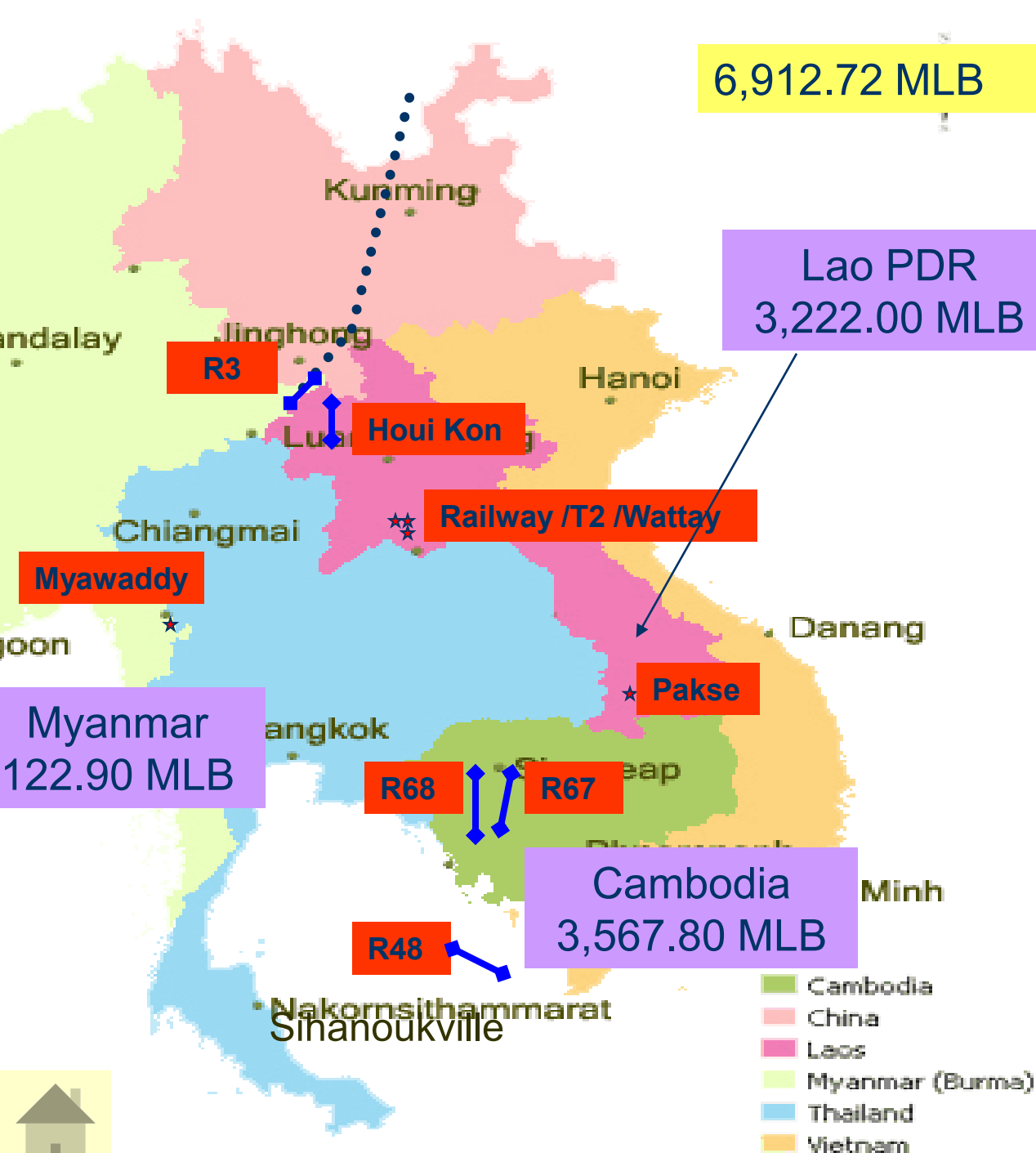

# NEDA's Future Prospect (2)

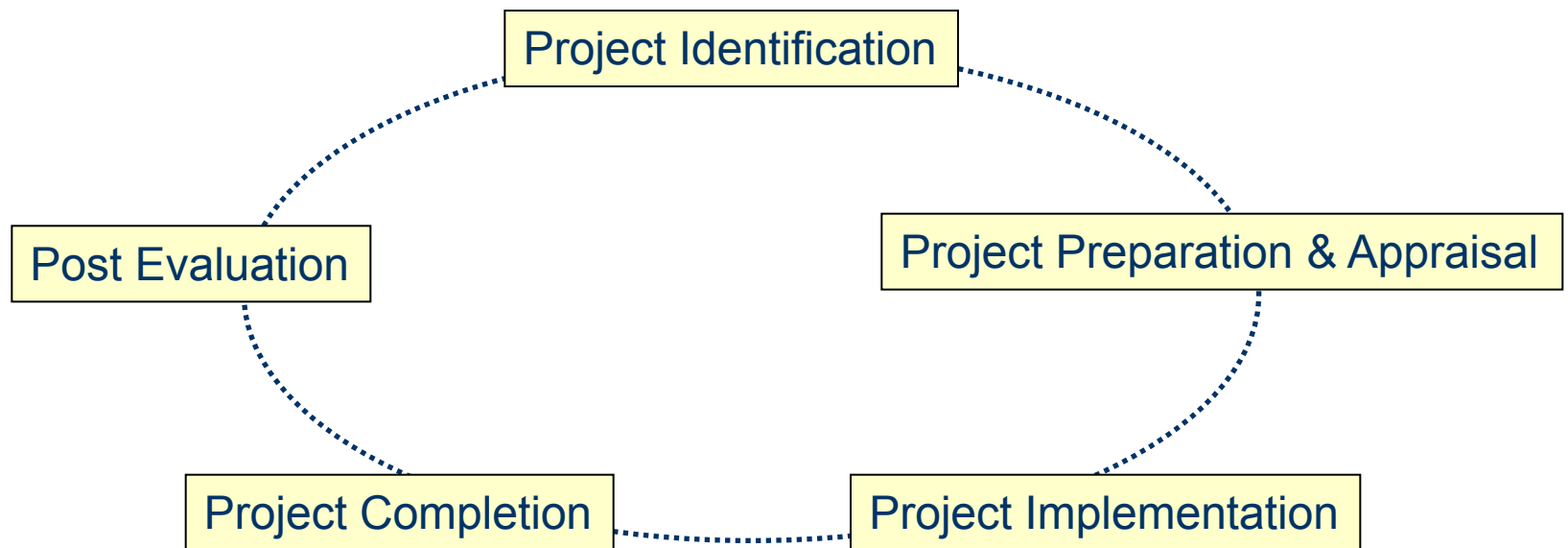
## Collaborate with Domestic or International Agencies

# Project Identification

- **Country and sector study**
- **Discussion with authorities from government and private sector and people in the project area**
- **Set up a plan (list the projects for the next 3 years)**
- **Arrange a seminar to brainstorm ideas**
- **Identify financial and technical assistance project**

# Project Preparation and Appraisal

- Collaboration cooperation with recipient countries
- Data collection, Survey and Interview beneficiaries
- Approval for F/S, Conceptual Design and Detailed Design
- Procurement procedures for consulting services
- Approval for financial assistance

# Project Implementation

## Monitoring, Survey and Site visit

- Monitor progress and disbursement
- Discussion with local community (by recipient countries)
- Early detection of obstacles
- Discussion with executing agency on possible solutions

# Project Completion

- Survey and collect data by interviewing people in project area
- Finalize completion report
- Reveal the report to concerning agencies and the public
- CSR



# Post Evaluation

- Evaluation work plan
  - Evaluation methodology, questions, data collection, methods and schedule
- Data collection, survey and interview
- Analysis
- Producing a project evaluation report
- Reporting (lesson learned/ recommendation) to related agencies and recipient
