## problem analysis

#### the Lusaka Declaration enlarges the role of the ICGLR Secretariat

in addition to coordinating and facilitating political processes, it now also is expected to **guide and oversee the implementation** of the RINR

- making human and financial resources operational for the advisory and coordinating tasks of the CS
- ensure monitoring of the RINR implementation and feedback to Member States
- strengthen coordination of donor support and assure better linkage to international initiatives and processes




the level of societies

- discuss potential difficulties and come up with joint solutions






#### objectives (continued)

- assess the possibilities for interventions of new actors to provide support to the RINR and its implementation in the ICGLR Member States



## RINR as a learning field





**cooperation:** establish ICGLR as key stakeholder, create international dimension, incorporate wide range of stakeholders, build on existing initiatives

**steering structure:** establish a formal platform between all MS, ensure regularity of meetings

processes: combine political process with technical approach

**learning and innovation:** scale-up from pilots, role-out to other initiatives
