#### Education at Glance 2014: OECD Indicators

The [2014 edition of Education at Glance](#) provides new education and skills data for 45 countries on the structure, finances, and performance of education systems. It also draws on the OECD databases of the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA), the Survey of Adult Skills (PIAAC), and Teaching and Learning International Survey (TALIS), providing the richest international evidence base on education and skills ever produced.

### **Directorate for Education and Skills – new Director**

Andreas, a German national, joined the Organisation as an official in 1994, and has held the position of Deputy Director of the Education and Skills Directorate (EDU) since 2012 and Special Advisor to the Secretary-General since 2010. ### **State of Higher Education 2014: Articles from Experts**

[Sir Peter Scott](#)'s article on universities and university business models focuses on the tensions between the “entrepreneurial university” and the “ivory tower” university, from which flow nearly all the active policy and management issues that preoccupy higher education leaders today. Professor Scott notes that the market shift in higher education may help entrench existing institutional hierarchies as much as or more than it has stimulated novelty. He therefore recommends a balanced approach to new business models in higher education, rather than uncritically accepting the rhetoric of the “entrepreneurial university”.

[Professor Jane Knight](#) (Canada) and [Professor Guy Neave](#) (France) will also contribute articles for the 2014 volume of the *State of Higher Education*. The publication will be available exclusively to members of the OECD Higher Education Programme in December 2014.



### **HANDS-ON, training teachers in the use of ICTs**

A MOOC to learn and design ICT-based learning design activities, the [Hands-On ICT](#) project aims at facilitating the integration of ICT tools in teaching and learning by developing a learning-by-doing environment, designed to be explored by educators, individually, or with the guidance of a peer-mentor.

On 27 October 2014, the HANDS-ON project will launch the third edition of the “Learning Design Studio for ICT-based Learning Activities” MOOC. The HANDS-ON consortium is looking for educators to participate in a free, open and online course (MOOC) that will support you in the creation and adaptation of your lessons and learning activities with the use of ICT tools. The course will last 5 weeks and a group of facilitators will support you in the task of designing your own learning activities and lessons. The course will be offered in six languages: English, Spanish, Catalan, Greek, Slovenian and French.

## **Universitat Rovira I Virgili in the “100 under 50” THE ranking**

[URV](#) is the 66th best university in the world under 50 years of age, according to the Times Higher Education’s (THE) ranking [100 Under 50](#). This is the first time that the URV is part of the top 100 most valued universities for this ranking, which has been around since 2012.

URV’s best scores were achieved in the following indicators: scientific publication citations, internationalisation, relationships with industry, and teaching and research. The ranking has been re-calibrated and given less weight to subjective indicators of academic reputation in order to reflect the special characteristics of younger universities.

The URV was also listed, for the very first time, among the best 400 universities in the world according to the 2013-14 edition of the [THE World University Rankings](#). Phil Baty, the THE rankings editor, outlines that this classification provides a glimpse into the future, as it includes “those [institutions] showing the most potential to be world leaders”.

Moreover, URV is leading the list of most cited articles among Spanish universities, according to the [Leiden ranking](#). This ranking measures the scientific impact of worldwide universities and their scientific collaboration. URV is placed 180th among 750 universities in the world, and 82 in Europe.
