

## AZIM IBROHIM

Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Tajikistan

H.E. Deputy Prime Minister Ibrohim was born on 1 March 1962 in the Republic of Tajikistan.

In 1984 he graduated with distinction from Tashkent State Technical University.

In 1992 he earned his degree - Candidate of Technical Sciences (equivalent to PhD) in Moscow State Mining University (The Russian Federation);

From 1992 to 1994 he served as a senior lecturer and the Director of Technological University of Tajikistan;

1994 - 1995 – the First Deputy Chairman of the Committee of GOSGORTECHNADZOR under the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Tajikistan

From 1995 to 1997 he served as the First Deputy Chairman of the Committee for Precious Stones and Semi-precious Raw Materials;

1997 - 2002 - the First Deputy Chairman of the Committee on Precious Metals under the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan;

2002 - 2004 - Deputy Minister – the Head of the Department of Mining Industry and Precious Metals of the Ministry of Industry of the Republic of Tajikistan;

2004 - 2005 - the Chairman of Sino district of Dushanbe city;

2005 - 2013 – the Head of the Main Department of Geology under the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan;

Since November 23, 2013 – Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Tajikistan.

H.E. Deputy Prime Minister Ibrohim was awarded the title of the best inventor of Tajikistan in 2000-2001.

He is the author of five books (three in co-authorship), more than 60 published scientific articles and five inventions (four in co-authorship);

Since 2004 – a member of the editorial board of the "Mining Journal", Moscow, The Russian Federation.

He is Academician of International Engineering Academy, Academician of International Academy of Mineral Resources (The Russian Federation), was awarded the Order "Sharaf" II degree, has a title "Honoured worker of Tajikistan".
