Mr. Tripathi has served as the United Nations Recovery Coordinator for Aceh and Nias since January 2007, heading the United Nations Office responsible for coordinating and facilitating international support to recovery efforts including that of the United Nations, providing policy and strategic advice to the Indonesian Agency for Reconstruction and Rehabilitation (BRR till April 2009 and now BKRA and BKRN) and the respective provincial governments, and ensuring structured approaches to longer-term recovery.

Mr. Tripathi has served with the UN in key positions in various post-conflict/post-disaster countries in Europe, Asia and Africa spanning a broad range of tasks and responsibilities including Humanitarian Affairs, Human Rights, Programme Planning and Assessment, Public Sector Restructuring, Economic Governance and Legal Affairs.

A lawyer and an economist by training, Mr. Tripathi has also held responsible government positions as a member of the national civil services of India and has varied experience in governance, rule of law and development issues.
