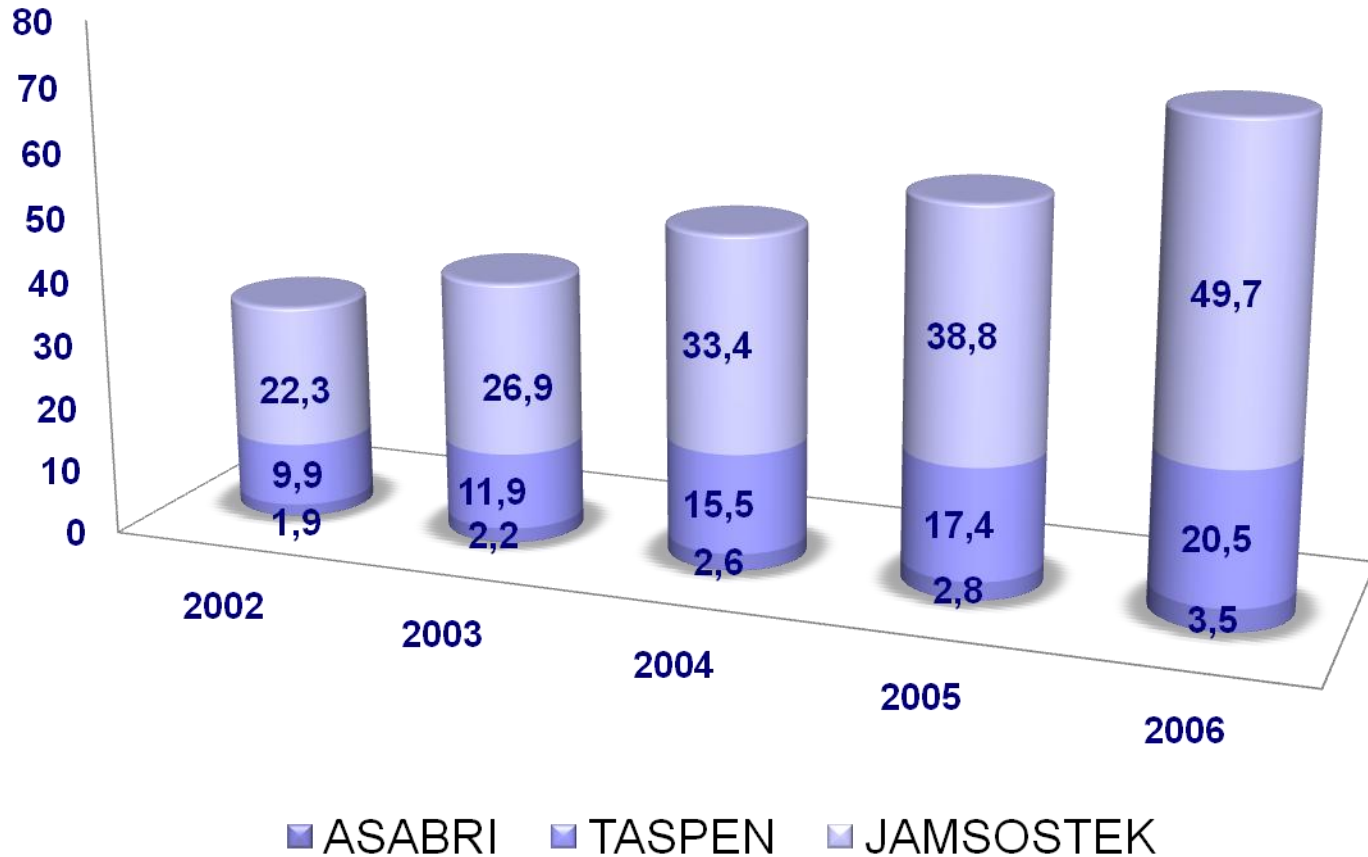

 - Financial institution pension funds

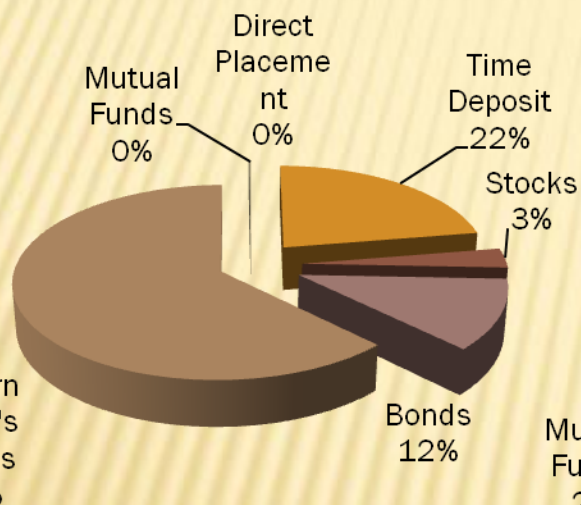
The Assets of Publicly Managed Fund (in trillion Rp)



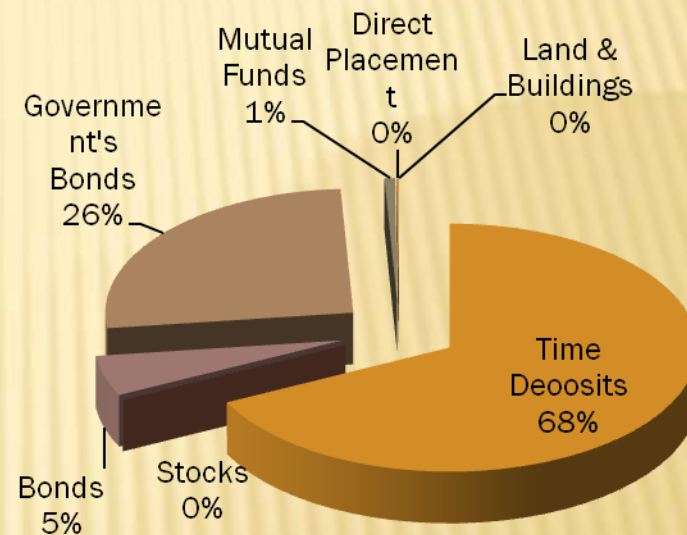
INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO OF PUBLICLY MANAGED FUNDS

AS OF DESEMBER,31 2006

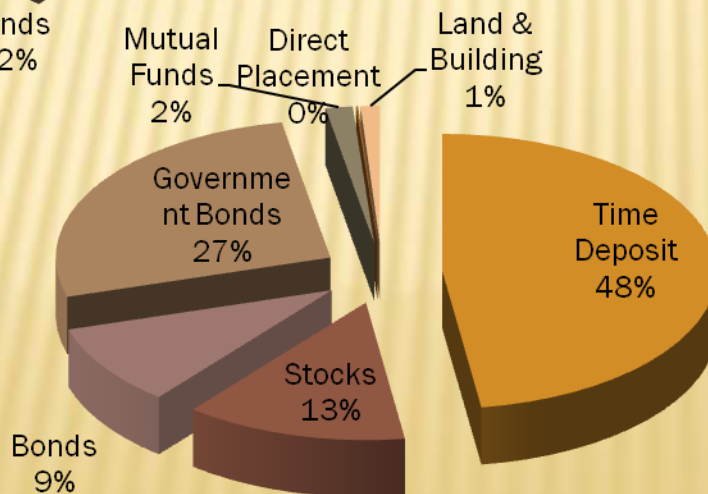

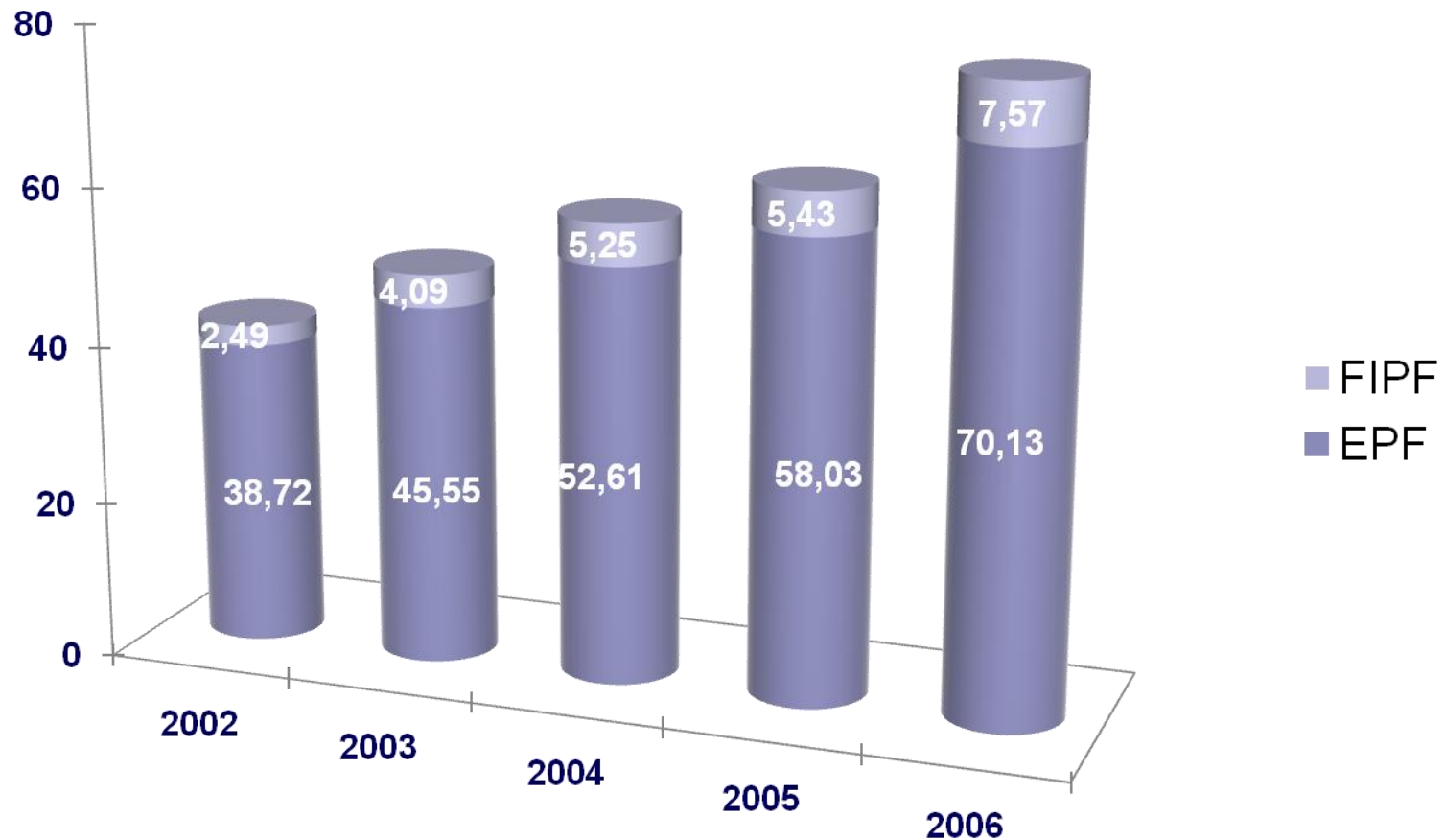

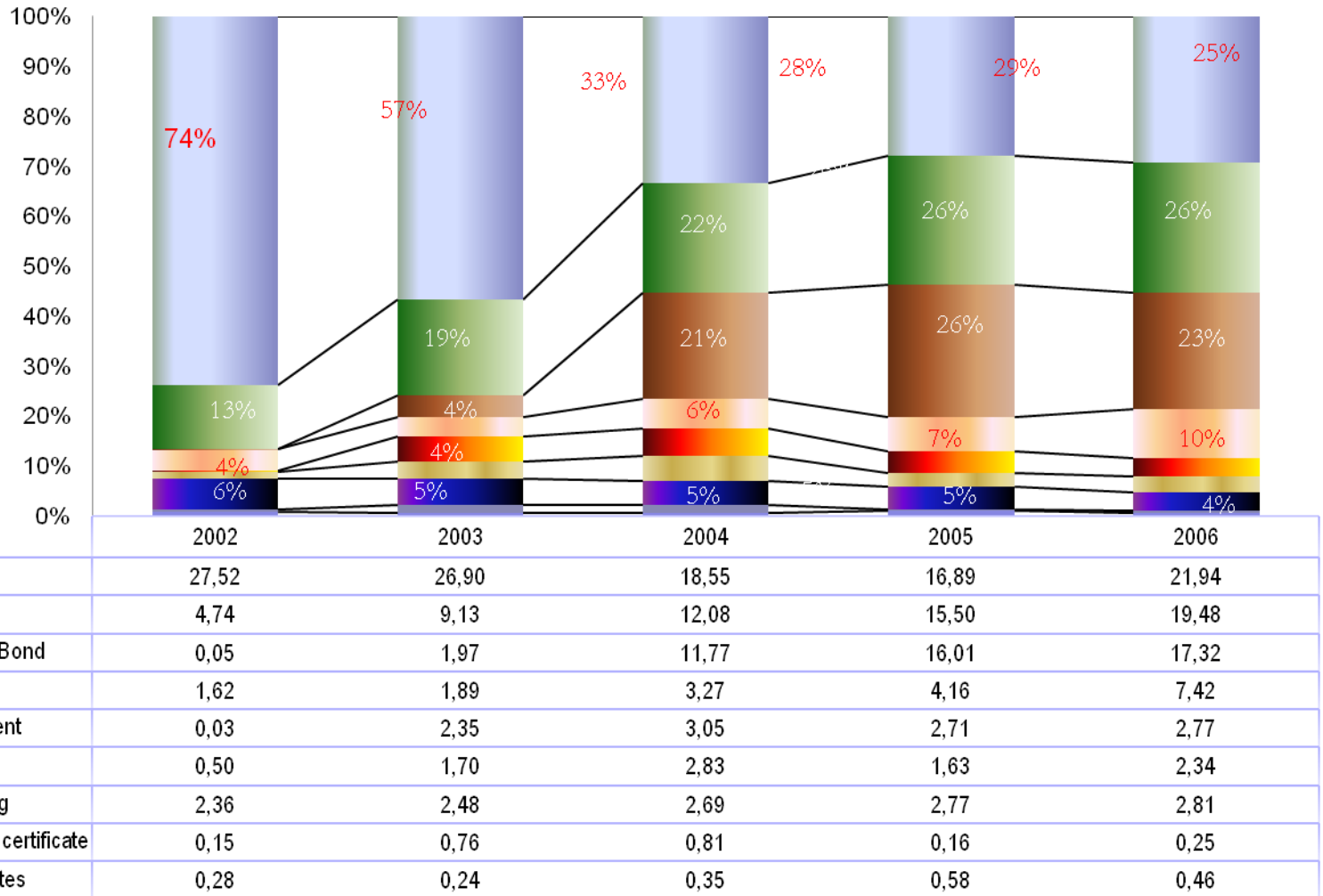
