



## Digital Government Strategies: Good Practices



 **Netherlands: DigiCommissioner**

The OECD Council adopted on 15 July 2014 the Recommendation on Digital Government Strategies. The Recommendation provides a set of 12 principles structured around 3 pillars. The OECD Secretariat is developing a Digital Government Policy Toolkit to support OECD member countries and non-member adhering countries with the implementation of the Recommendation. This practice was submitted by the government of Netherlands to be considered as a good practice in the implementation of one or more of the principles contained in the Recommendation.

### Description of the practice:

<b>Name of the practice:</b>	DigiCommissioner
<b>Principles implemented:</b>	<u>Principle 5</u> – Secure leadership and political commitment
<b>Description:</b>	The Council of Ministers has appointed in 2014 a National DigiCommissioner (high level person) to push for arrangement of financing, governance and use of the (different provisions, infrastructure and services) of the digital government in the Netherlands. The appointment will last 4 years at most.

The DigiCommissioner has put a governance in place with on top a top-level civil servants and a ministerial Commissioner. The governance exists of all levels of government (national, regional, local and functional)
