## **Measuring PCD for Food Security**

#### **Measurement of PCD**

- Impact of OECD policies in developing countries
  - does positive impact = coherence?
  - design or co-incidence?
- PCD is when development impacts influence domestic policy formulation
  - measurement of impact provides evidence <u>for</u> PCD more than evidence <u>of</u>
    PCD
  - PCD measurement has been more on effort and institutions than on outcomes
  - Evidence of PCD in policy making processes is necessary
  - assess value vs opportunity costs
  - to address new issues
  - to convince new actors

## **Measuring PCD for Food Security**

### Measuring coherence with what?

- the D in PCD becomes more specific and therefore so does the Coherence
- donor Food Security programmes
- Comprehensive Framework for Action (CFA)
- national strategies for Food Security

#### Coherence of what?

- Domestic policies
- Development policies and ODA
- Economic and other non- ODA co-operation with developing countries

#### Evidence – what to examine?

- Domestic policy making process numbers of policies and changes made
- Coherence processes in ODA policy making and planning
- Actions at country programme level to counter impacts of donor incoherence
