Synthesis Report of the Secretary-General on the Post-2015 Agenda


- We are a mobile world, with more than **232 million international migrants** – and almost one billion when internal migrants are counted.
- The agenda must not exclude **migrants, refugees, displaced persons**, or persons affected by conflict.
- Ensuring that all people, including women, persons with disabilities, youth, aged, and **migrants** have decent employment, social protection, and access to financial services, will be a hallmark of our economic success.
- Efforts should be intensified to **reduce costs on the transfer of remittances**, in a manner fully respecting **the rights of migrants**.




