Took effect at the end of June 2012

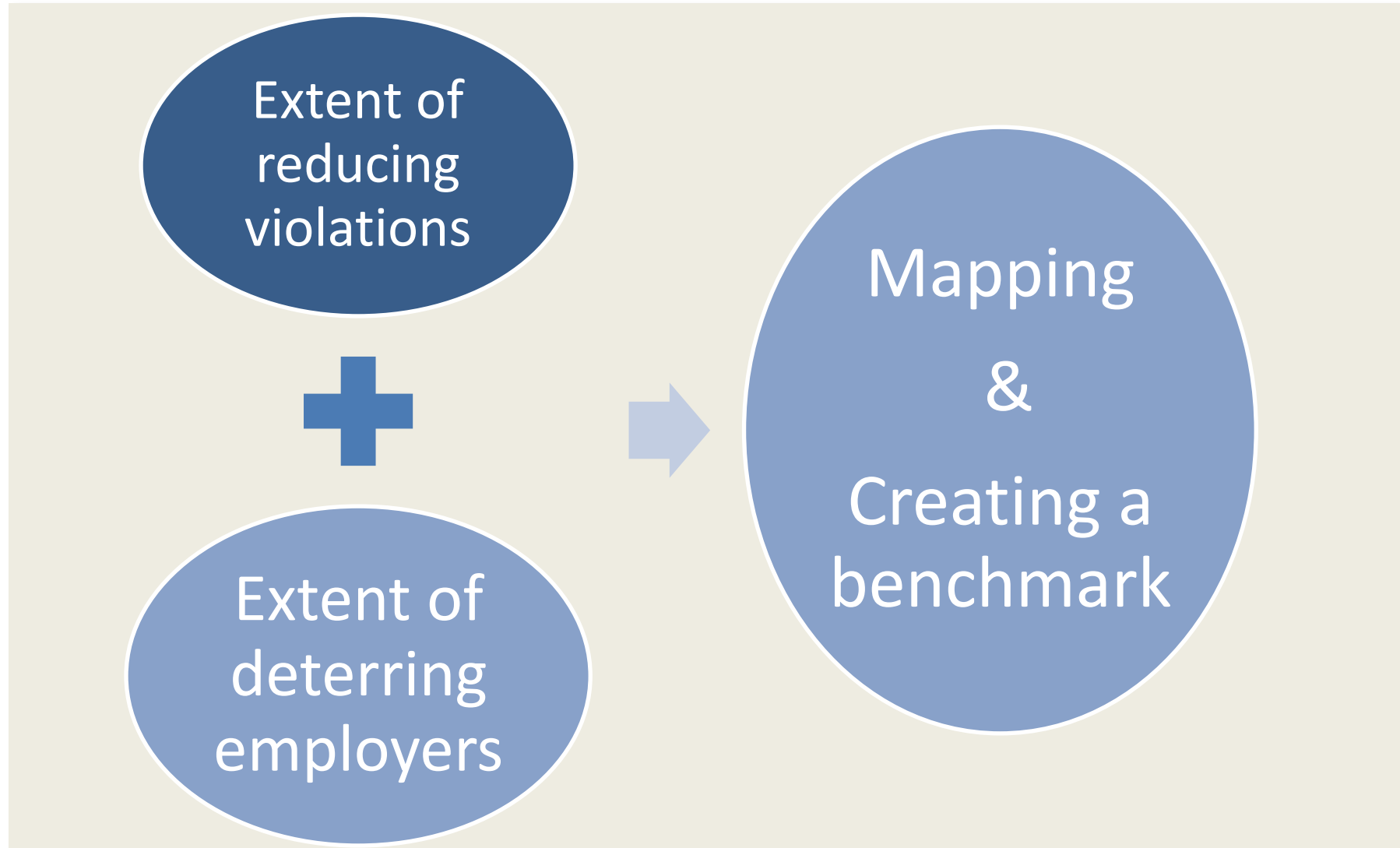
Quick and efficient enforcement → administrative enforcement

Applies to all employees, including contractor employees and those who do not have “employee-employers” relations.

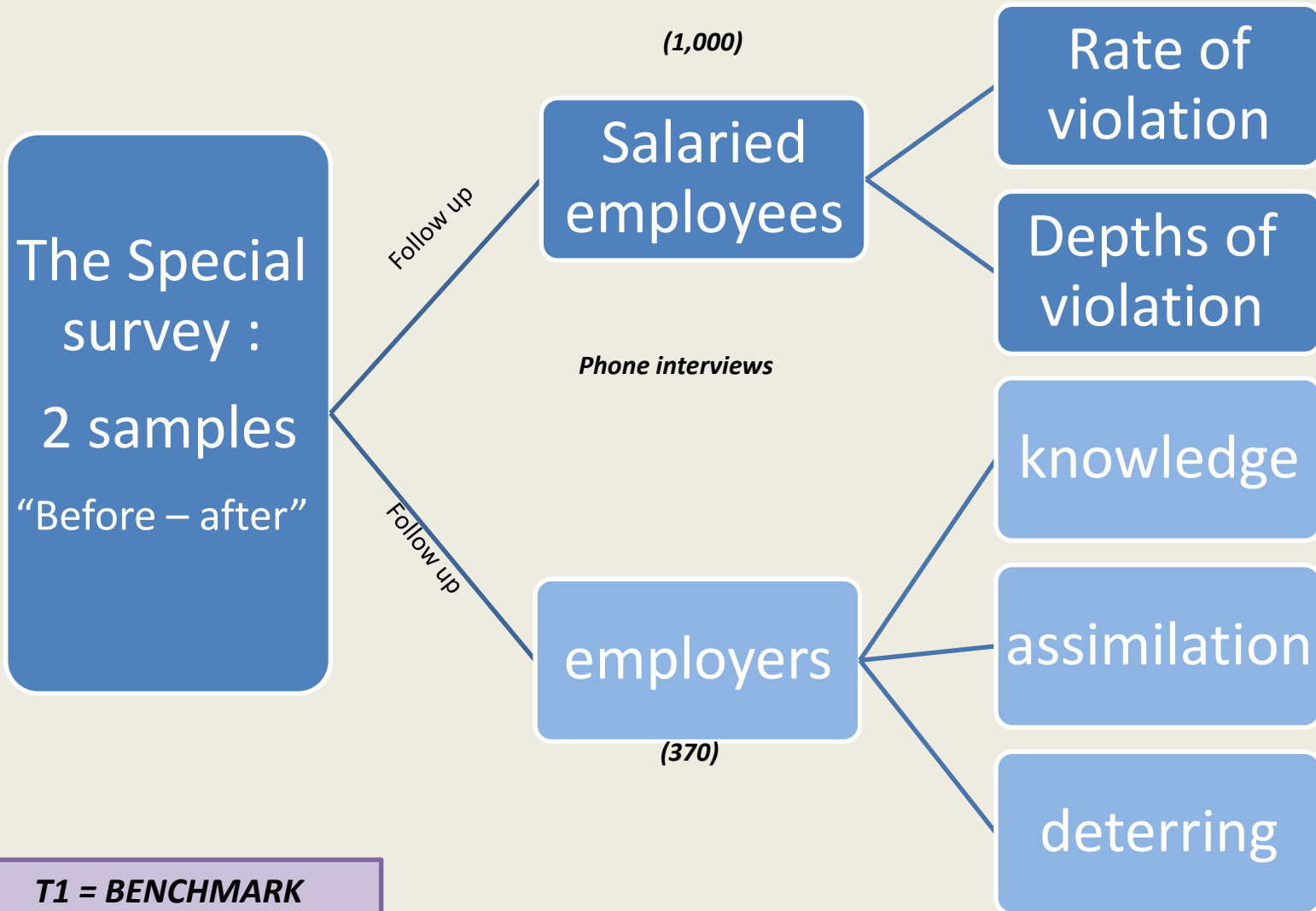

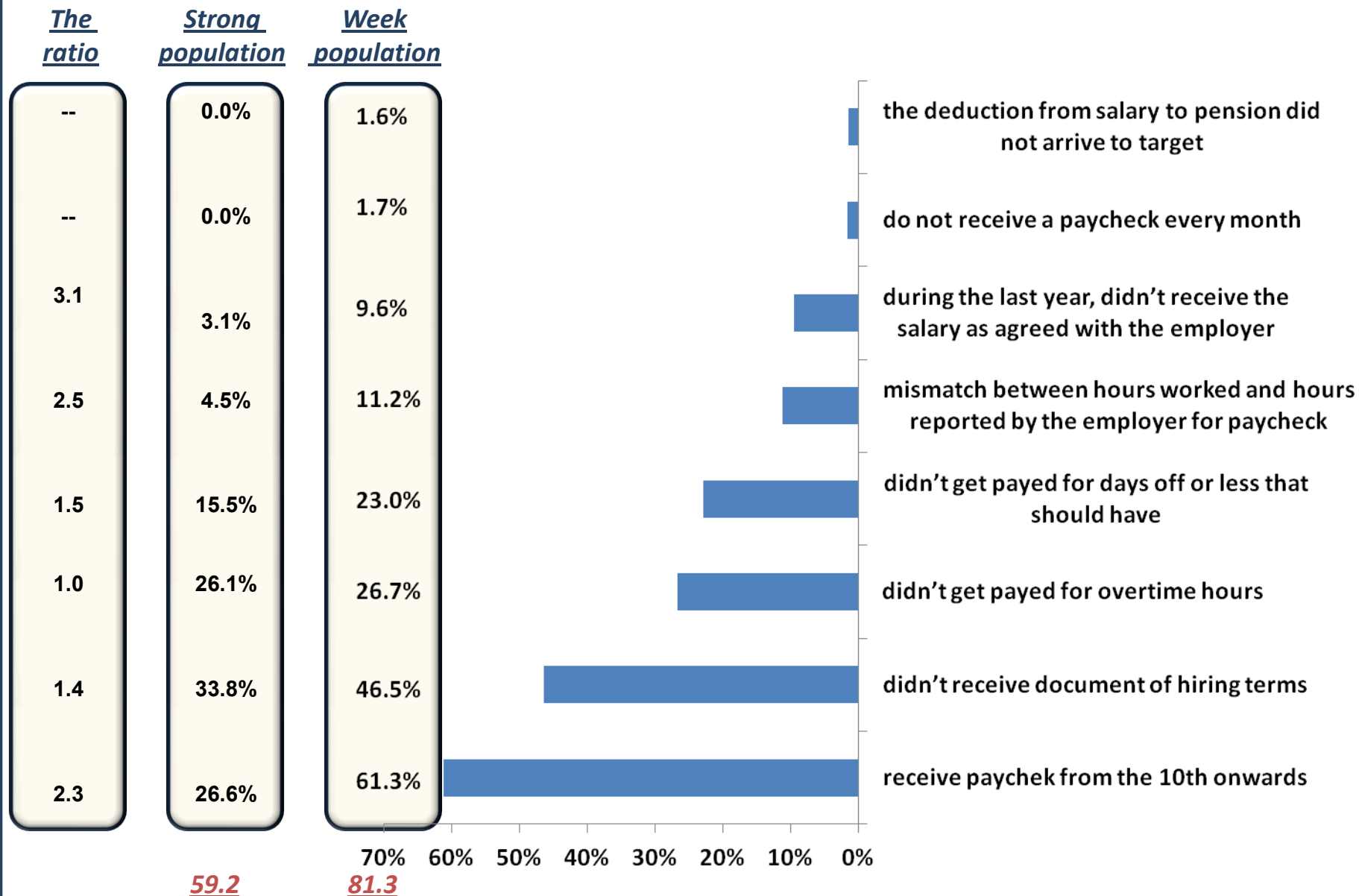

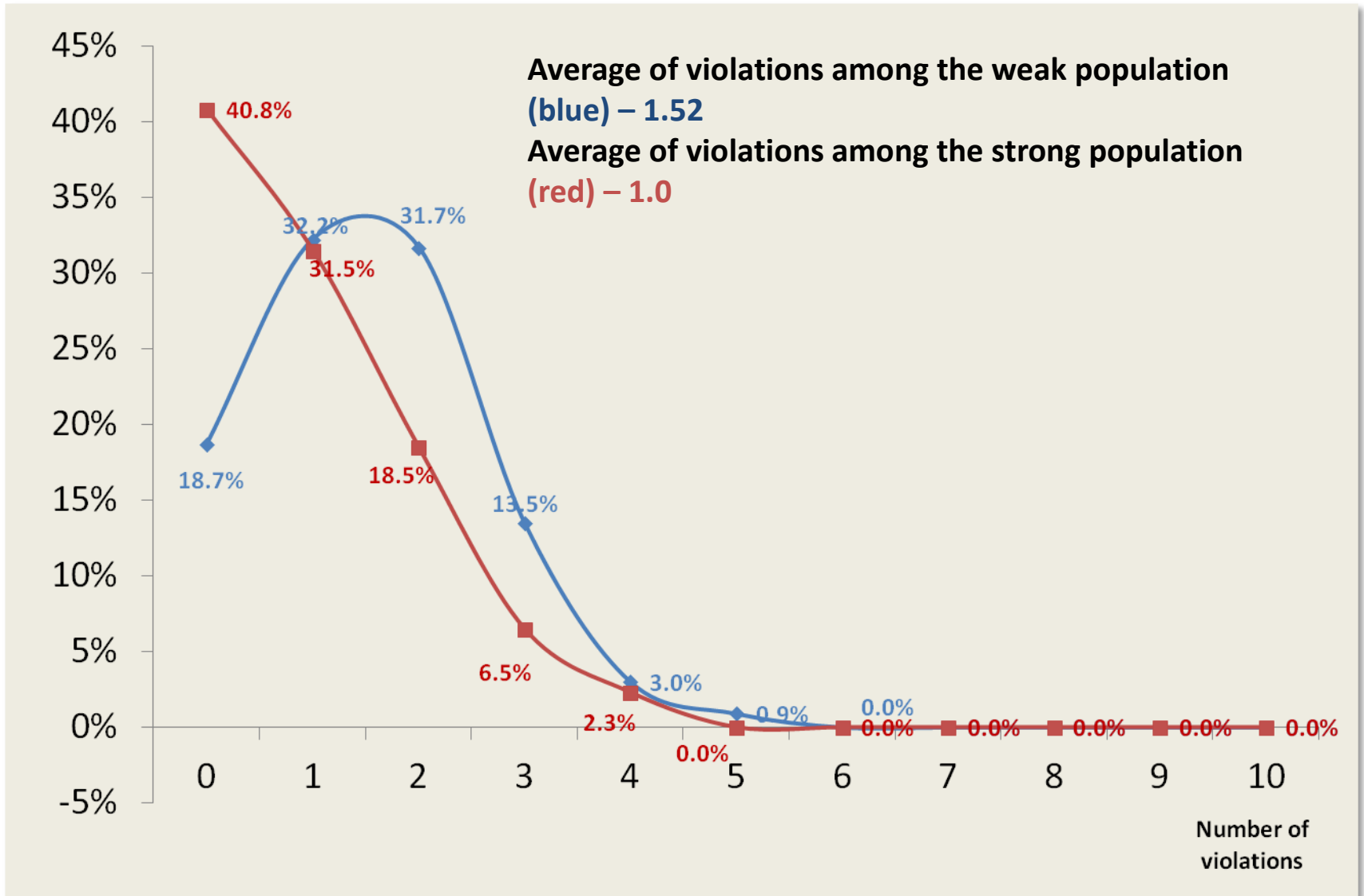
Data analysis - Detecting target groups
