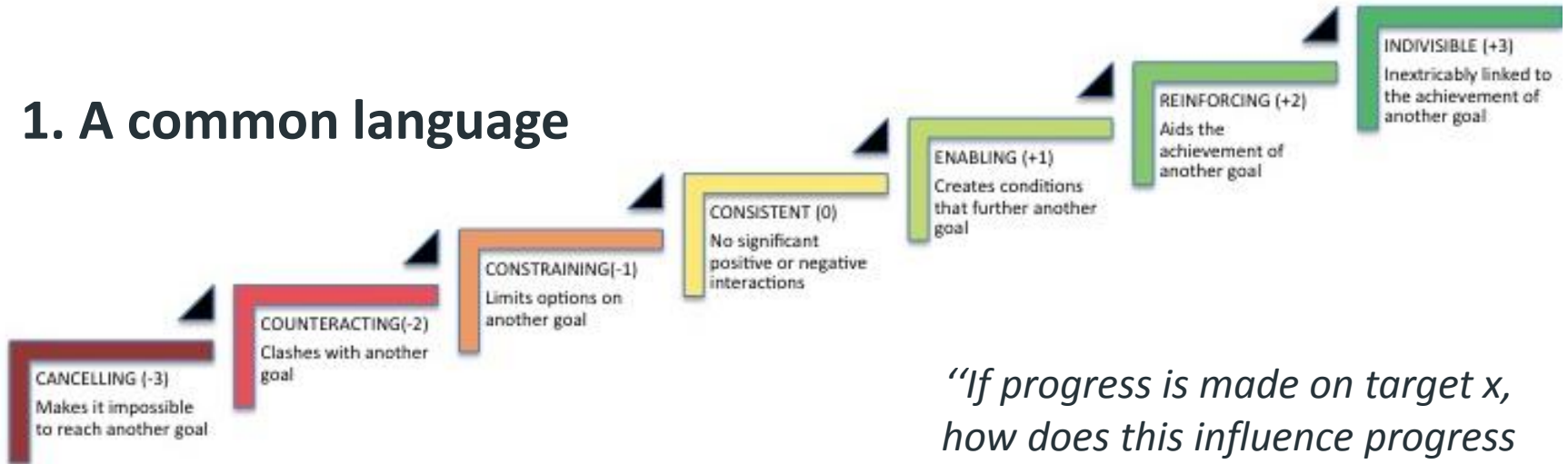

SDG Target	Rank

1. Enables **PRIORITY-SETTING** that accounts for how targets interact
2. Clarifies shared interests and dependencies and can thus guide **COLLABORATION**
3. **SYSTEMS ANALYSIS** shows effects beyond the sum of individual interactions
4. A common language and process provides **TRANSPARENCY**
5. **CONTEXTUAL** assessment make insights policy relevant
