

FRANCIS LORENTZ

Francis LORENTZ is **President of « Mission Commerce Electronique »**, a Government and Industry task force dedicated to E-business development. He published in January 1998 and in January 1999 reports on E-commerce challenges for French industry and plans to cope with the major issues raised by digitalized transactions. He is also **Chairman of EPFR** (Etablissement Public que Financement et de Restructuration) and **Professor at Paris-Dauphine University** (strategic management - information technologies).

Born in 1942, he is graduate of HEC (Business school) and ENA (Civil service). He worked 10 years for the French Government (Treasury and Ministry of Industry) before joining the private industry as Deputy Managing Director at Lyonnaise des Eaux. End of 1982, he moved to the Information System industry, first as Chief Operating Officer of CII-Honeywell-Bull and later (1989) as Chief Executive Officer of Groupe Bull and Chairman of Bull North America. From 1992 to 1994, he was President of RATP (public transportation system of Paris area).
