President, Japanese Trade Union Confederation (JTUC-RENGO)

Nobuaki Koga was born on 23rd February 1952 in Fukuoka, Japan.

After earning a bachelor's degree in engineering from Miyazaki University, he joined Matsushita Electric Industrial Co., Ltd., and became a member of Matsushita Electric Industrial Workers' Union in April 1975. He was elected as General Secretary of Matsushita Electric Industrial Workers' Union in July 1994 and then as President in July 1996. He was elected as President of Japanese Electrical, Electronic & Information Union (DENKI RENGU) in July 2002, and President of Japan Council of Metalworkers' Unions (IMF-JC) in September 2004. He became General Secretary of Japanese Trade Union Confederation (JTUC-RENGO) in October 2005 and President of JTUC-RENGO in October 2009. In October 2011, he was re-elected as the President.
