Chart 1: Net Official Development Assistance Flows from DAC Members

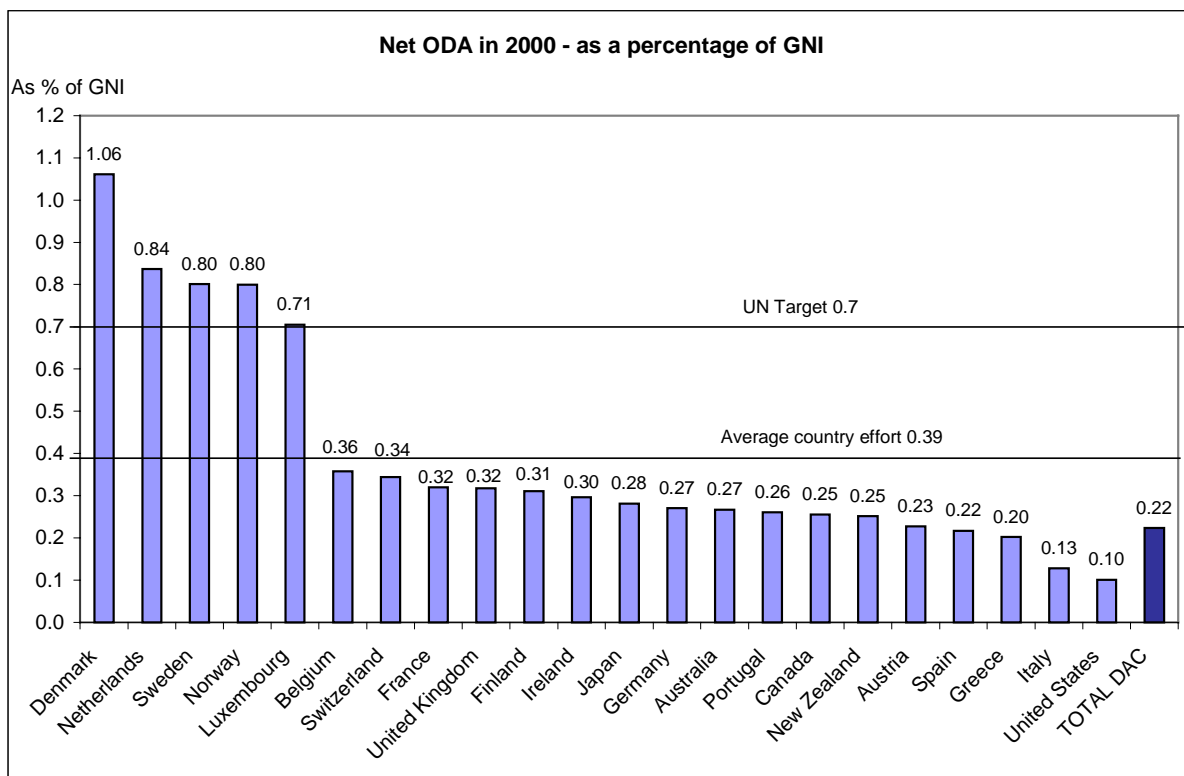
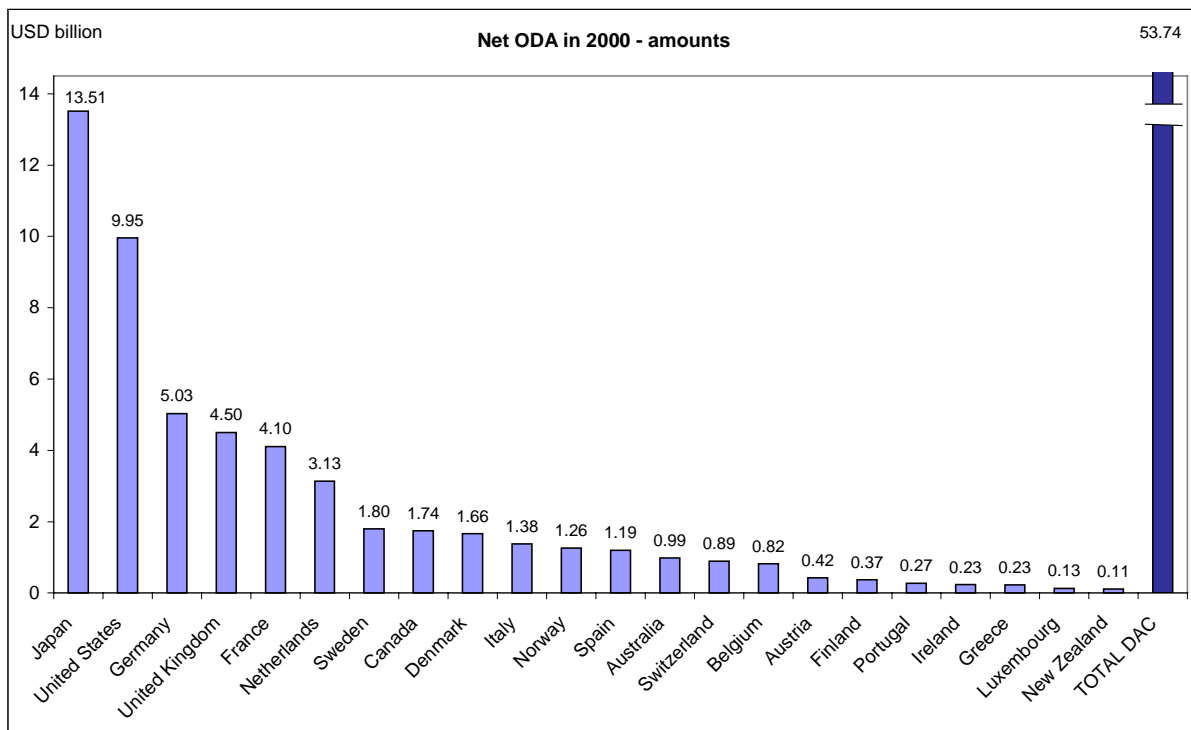
