Musa Ibrahim was an active member of the Committee that proposed the reforms in the Nigerian pension system including the introduction of the Contributory Pension Scheme. After the promulgation of the Pension Reform Act 2004, he was appointed a Commissioner in charge of Inspectorate Division in the National Pension Commission of to bring into effect the intent of the reform.

Until then, Dr. Musa Ibrahim was a staff of the Nigeria Deposit Insurance Corporation (NDIC) for over a decade. During his career at the NDIC, he served as the Chairman of the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN)/NDIC Technical Committee on Supervision from 2000 to 2004. In addition, he had a short stint as an Executive Director of a medium sized commercial bank under supervisory management.
