## PARTNERING

**A unique relationship with the LEED Programme**

Subnational governments, business and non-government organisations can partner with the LEED programme. Two levels of engagement are possible: **LEED Partner** and **LEED Strategic Partner**.

Partnering with LEED allows to:

- **call on OECD expertise** on the development of joint conferences and seminars of mutual interest;
- **upgrade their skills** by joining the training and capacity building seminars at the LEED Trento for local development in Italy;
- **increase their visibility** on all LEED Forum events and communication throughout the year [*reserved to LEED Strategic Partners*] and invite members of their networks to OECD events;
- **participate** in a selection on international conferences, seminar and experts' meetings to network and exchange knowledge with other partners and national policy makers;
