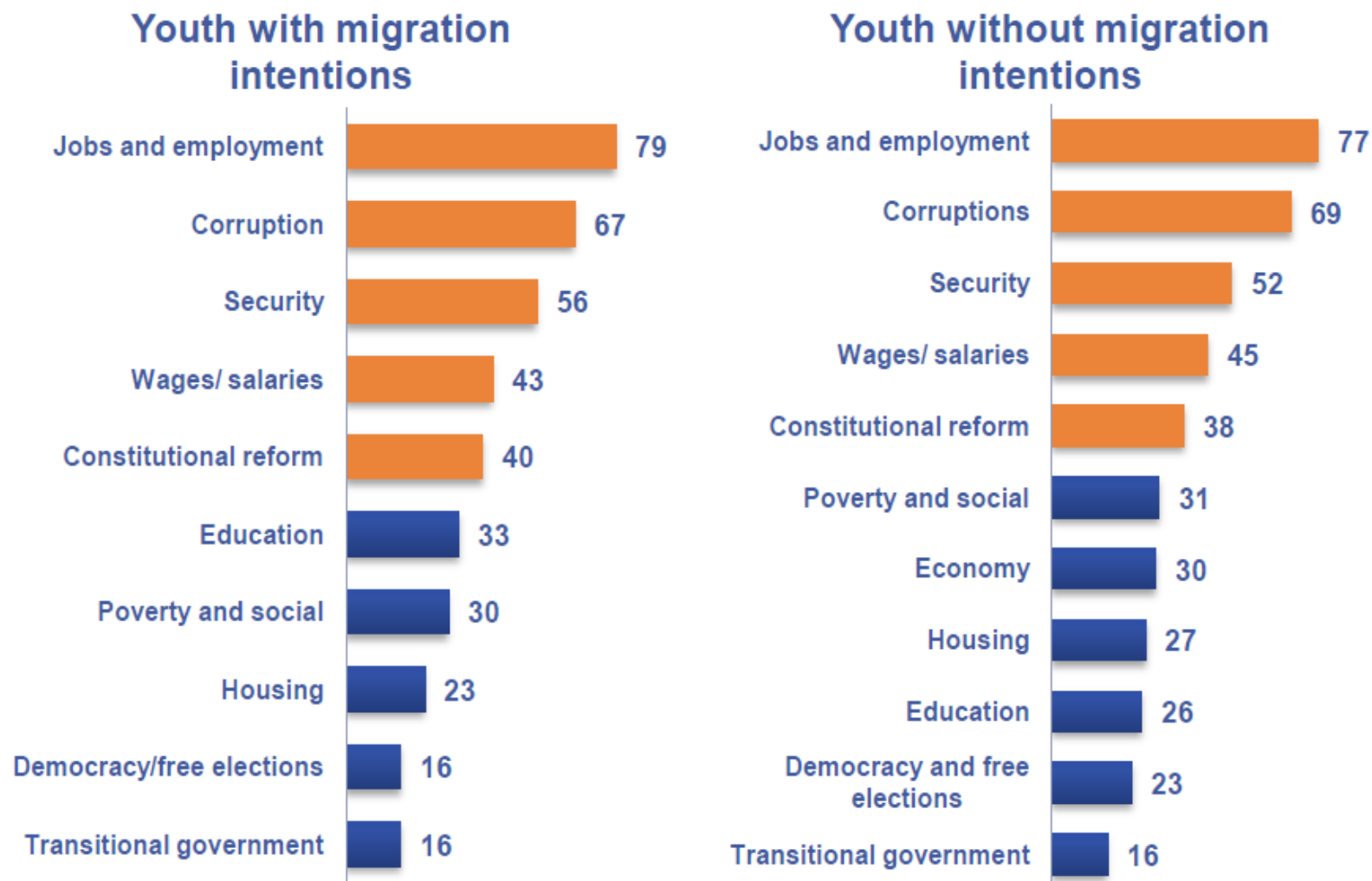

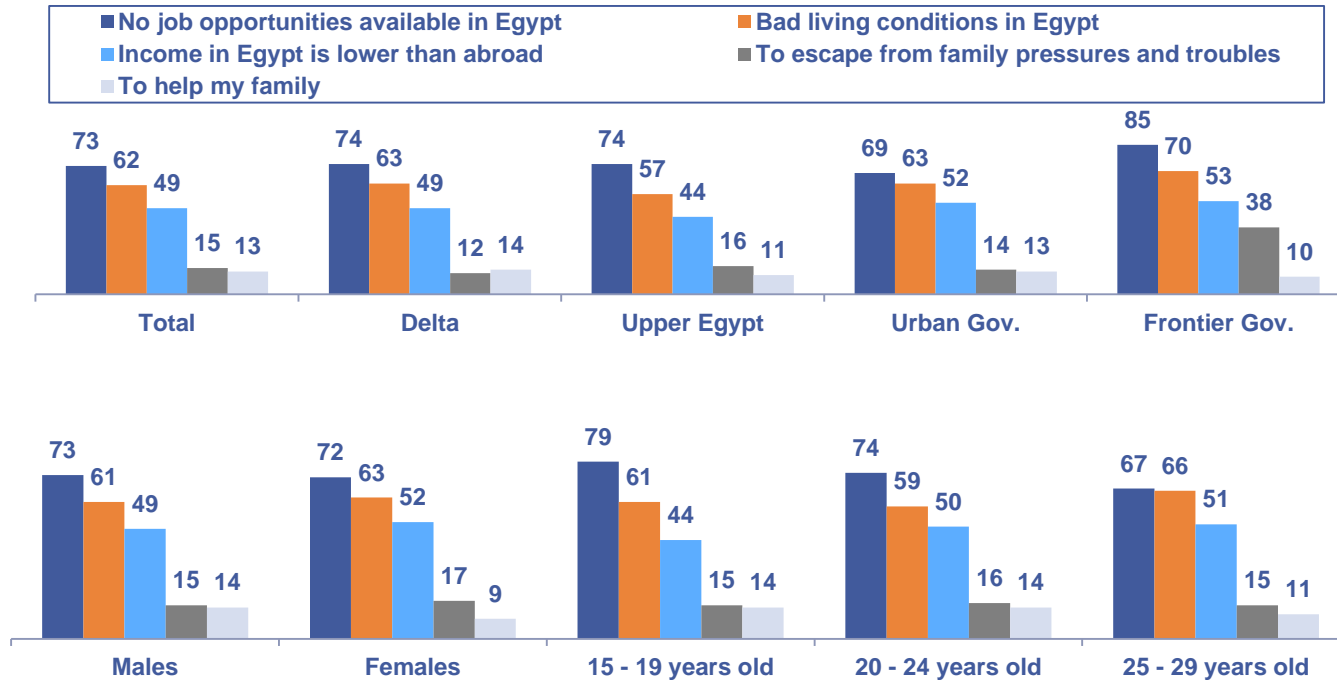

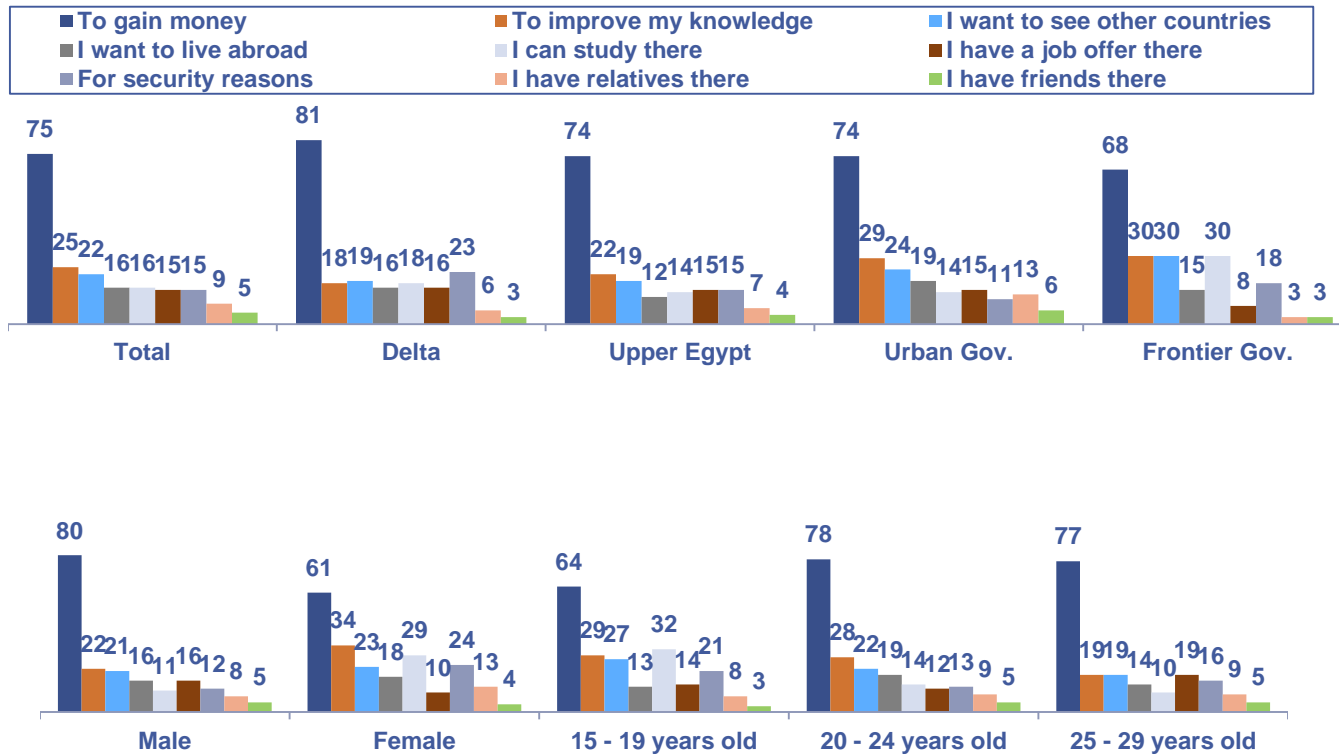
## Young Egyptians with and without migration intentions (%)



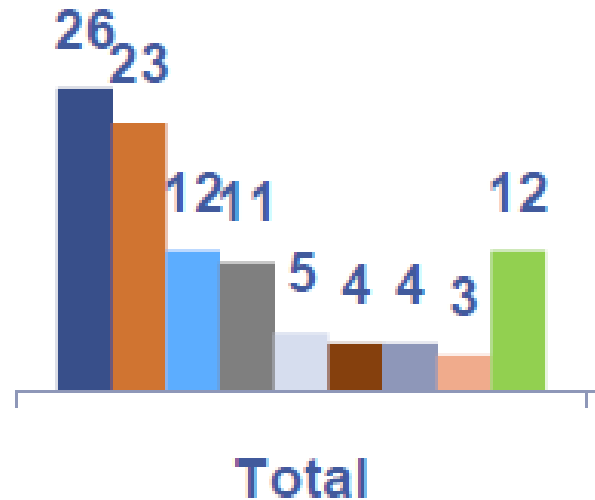
# Push and pull factors behind aspiration to migrate (%)

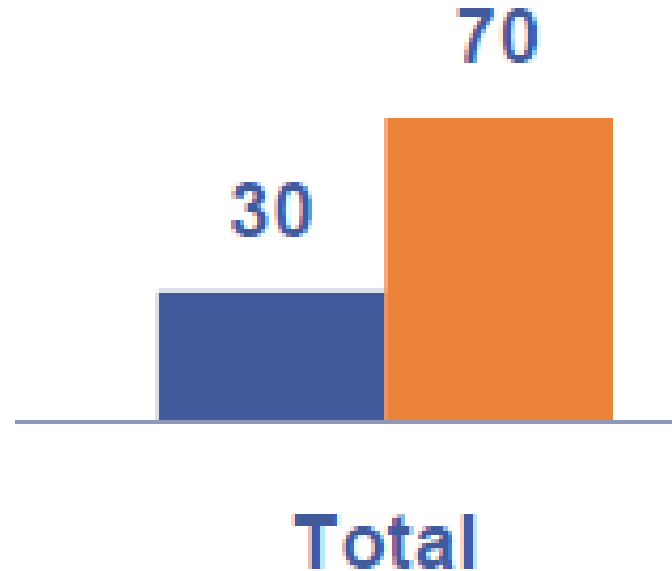


# Countries young Egyptian aspire to migrate to (%)

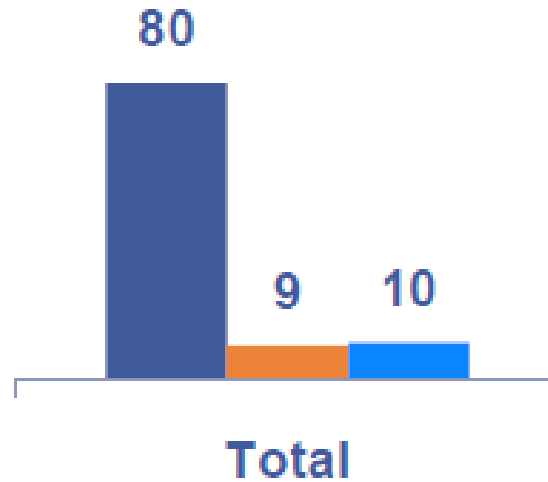
# Is it easy to migrate regularly? (%)

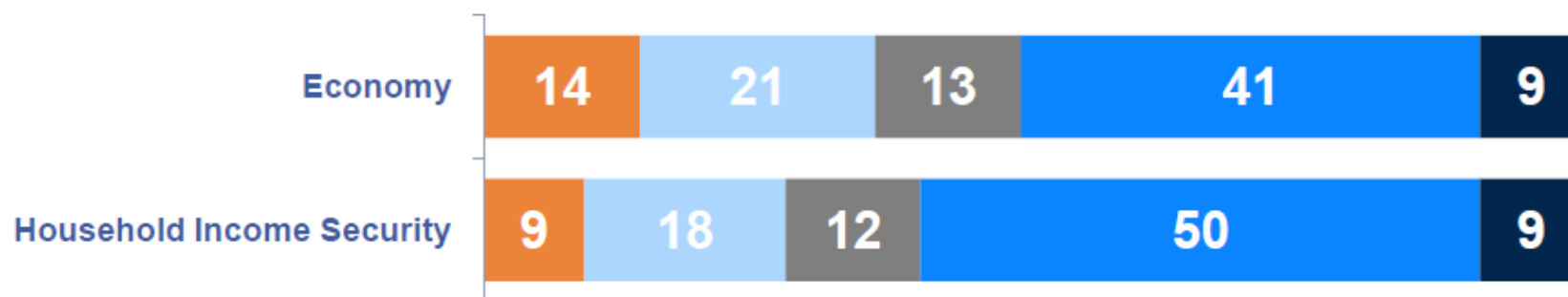

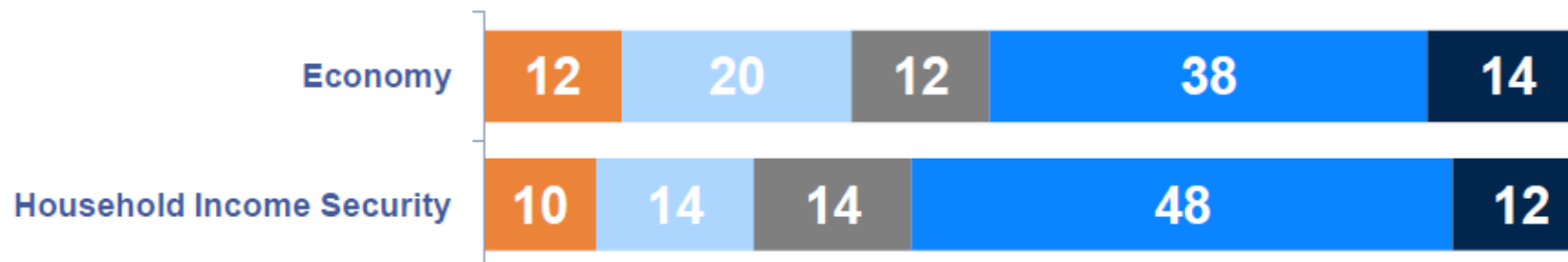

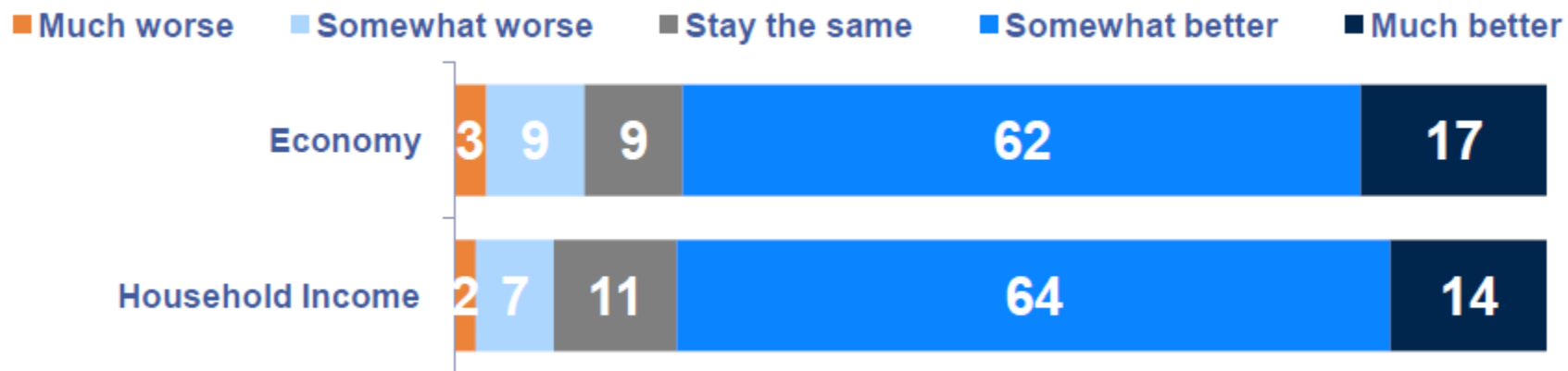
## Youth without migration intentions

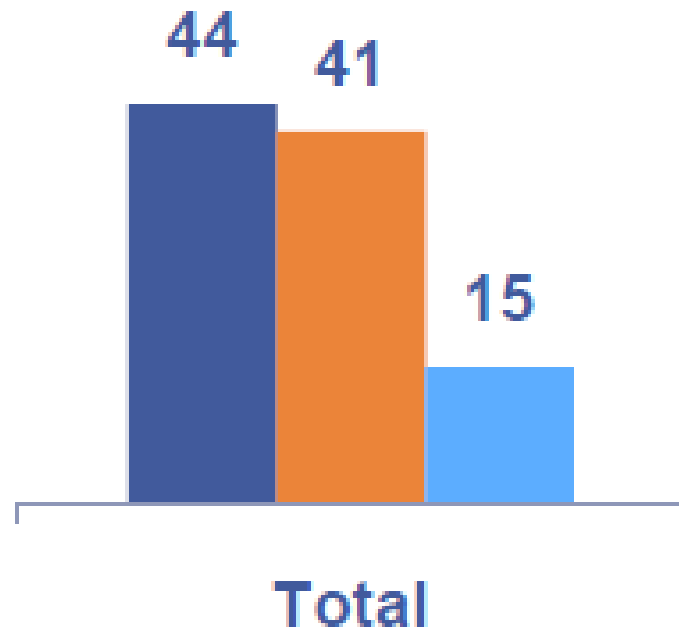




# Expectations for the economy and household income in the next year (%) for youth with migration intentions

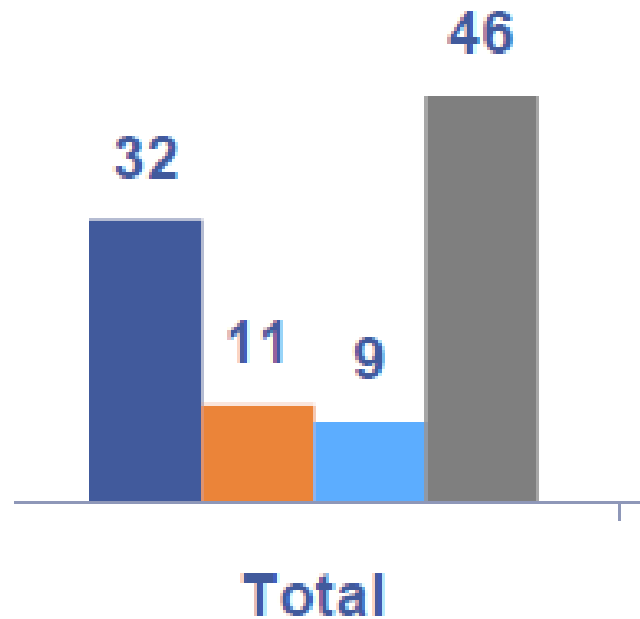


# Effect of the current events on their migration decision (%)



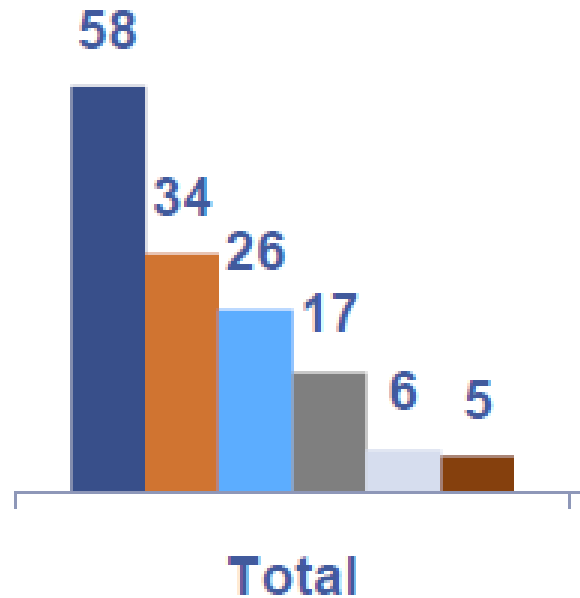
- No, I was planning to migrate before as well
