Biography

Dr. Çetin Ali Dönmez was born in 1967 in Istanbul. He is a graduate of Istanbul Pertevniyal High School. He received B.Sc. degree in Industrial Engineering in 1989, Master of Arts degree in 1992 and Finance Ph.D. degree in 2006 from Bogaziçi University.

He started his professional career as trading floor specialist at Borsa Istanbul Equity Market in 1990. He served as one of the key experts during the transition period of the exchange from traditional board trading method to electronic trading system. He was appointed to the derivatives market directorate position in 1996 and served as the team leader during the launch of derivatives trading electronic platform in Borsa Istanbul in 2001.

He is the founder of Borsa Istanbul Risk Management Department, he headed risk management team during 2006-2008. Mr. Dönmez was appointed as the CEO and Board Member of Turkish Derivatives Exchange in April 2008. He served as the CEO of Turkdex between 2008 and 2012.

He rejoined Borsa Istanbul in 2013 as Executive Vice President and served on this post until 2016. His area of responsibility was derivatives, precious metals and precious stones market as well as precious metals custody. He also headed the team of experts at Borsa Istanbul while he served as the CFO of the company during 2013.

After resigning from Borsa Istanbul, Dönmez joined İbn Haldun University Graduate School of Business, Department of Management as an academician. He worked in İbn Haldun University between April, 2017 – July, 2018. During the same period he also served as a chief consultant to the chairman of an industrial company. He has been serving as the Deputy Minister of Industry and Technology since July 31, 2018. Çetin Ali Dönmez is married and has two daughters.
