In January of 2019 she was appointed Minister for Rural Affairs and her areas of responsibility include Regional growth and Rural affairs.

Jennie Nilsson entered the Riksdag, the Swedish parliament, in 2006 representing the County of Halland. Through her work in the Committee on Taxation, Committee on Finance and Committee on the Labour Market she has gained a broad experienced as a Member of Parliament. From 2012, she has been the Chair and later the Deputy chair of the Committee on Industry and Trade.
