



## Implementing the Anti-Corruption Action Plan for Asia-Pacific: Reforms and anti-corruption resources P.R. China

The People's Republic of China joined the ADB/OECD Anti-Corruption Initiative for Asia-Pacific in April 2005 ([▶ endorsement statement](#)) and is represented in the Initiative's Steering Group through its Ministry of Supervision. P.R. China hosted, in September 2005, the 5<sup>th</sup> Regional Anti-Corruption Conference for Asia-Pacific ([▶ conference proceedings](#)) and the Initiative's [7<sup>th</sup> Steering Group meeting](#).

### Anti-Corruption reform in the framework of the Action Plan

P.R. China's current priorities for reform under the Anti-Corruption Action Plan concern the [fight against business bribery and enhance ethics building](#).

P.R. China's reform progress is documented in the regular reports that the country delivered at the Steering Group meetings ([▶ reform progress](#)). The region-wide report on [Anti-Corruption Policies in Asia-Pacific](#) provides a horizontal overview of P.R. China's policies, institutions and frameworks as well as progress in this area as of the first quarter of 2006. The outcome of the Initiative's Thematic Reviews provides more detailed analysis of mechanisms to [curb corruption in public procurement](#) and the instruments in place to seek and provide [mutual legal assistance, extradition and the recovery of proceeds of corruption](#).
