

## Implementing the Anti-Corruption Action Plan for Asia-Pacific: Reforms and anti-corruption resources Cambodia

Cambodia joined the ADB/OECD Anti-Corruption Initiative for Asia-Pacific in March 2003 ([▶ endorsement statement](#)) and is represented in the Initiative's Steering Group through its Anti-Corruption Unit at the Office of the Council of Ministers.

### Anti-Corruption reform in the framework of the Action Plan

Cambodia's reform progress is documented in the regular reports that the country delivered at the Steering Group meetings ([▶ reform progress](#)).
