The Fiji Islands joined the ADB/OECD Anti-Corruption Initiative for Asia-Pacific in November 2001 ([▶ endorsement statement](#)) and is represented in the Initiative's Steering Group through its Ministry of Finance and National Planning.

Anti-Corruption reform in the framework of the Action Plan
