

Implementing the Anti-Corruption Action Plan for Asia-Pacific: Reforms and anti-corruption resources Indonesia

Indonesia joined the ADB/OECD Anti-Corruption Initiative for Asia-Pacific in November 2001 ([▶ endorsement statement](#)) and is represented in the Initiative's Steering Group through its Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK). Indonesia hosted various events of the Initiative, such as, in 2007, the Initiative's [5th Regional Technical Seminar on Detecting, Avoiding and Managing Conflict of Interest](#), the [6th Regional Technical Seminar Asset recovery and Mutual Legal Assistance](#), and the [7th Regional Technical Seminar on fighting bribery in public procurement](#).

Anti-Corruption reform in the framework of the Action Plan
