



Compare your income – Data Protection Statement

The OECD is committed to the protection of personal information of the users of its websites and tools.

Information Collection and Use

Users are asked to provide basic information on their gender, country of residence, age and household size, as well as to provide their household's net income.

As income inequality can vary greatly within a country, IP addresses are also collected in order to generate geolocation information (the user's postal code and region).

This information is kept completely anonymous and confidential. We do not ask for your name, address or any other personally identifiable information.

In addition to providing users with immediate feedback on their survey responses, the OECD aggregates and analyses the anonymous responses. The aggregated results are made publicly available in a number of formats, including: OECD working papers, videos, social media content, etc.
