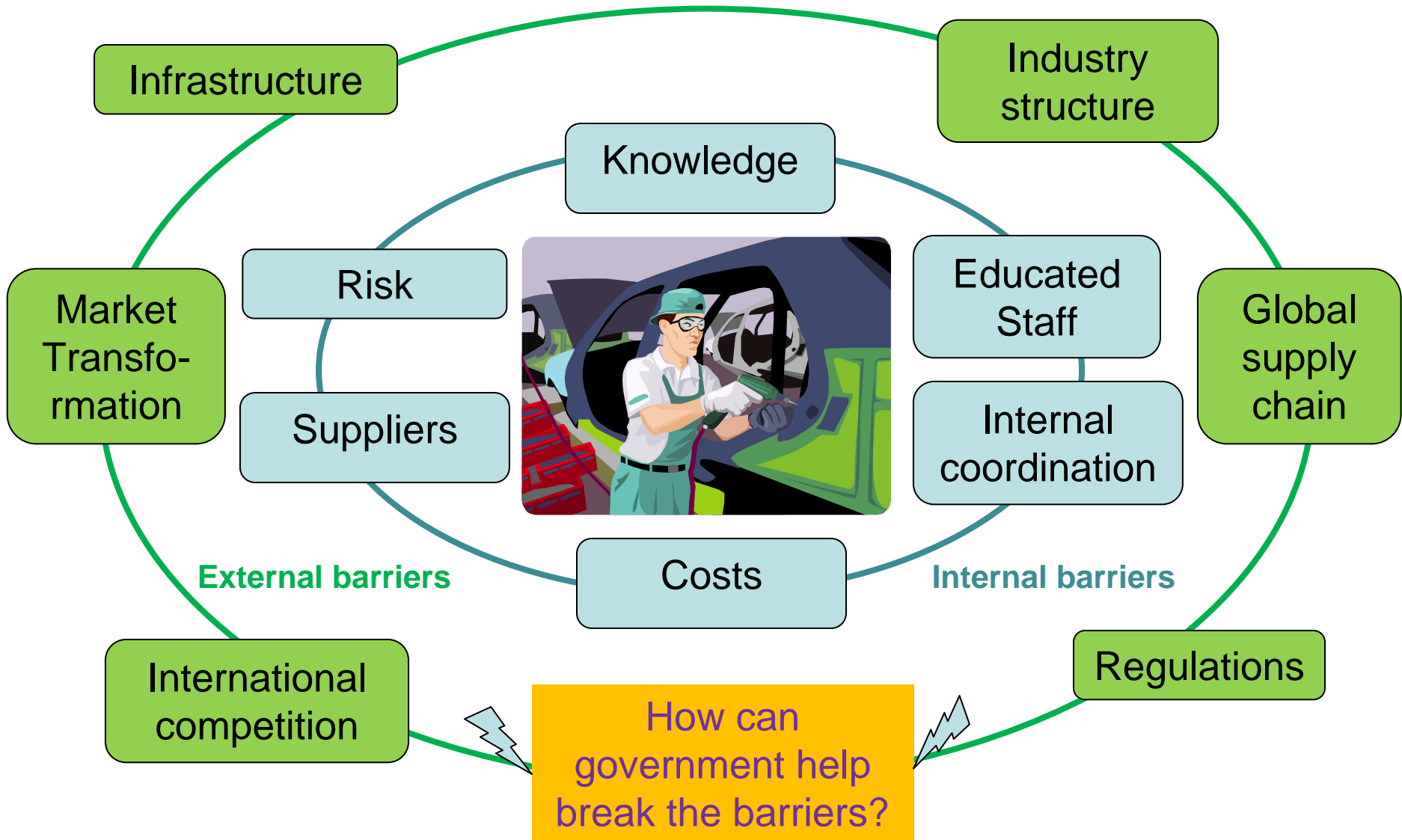

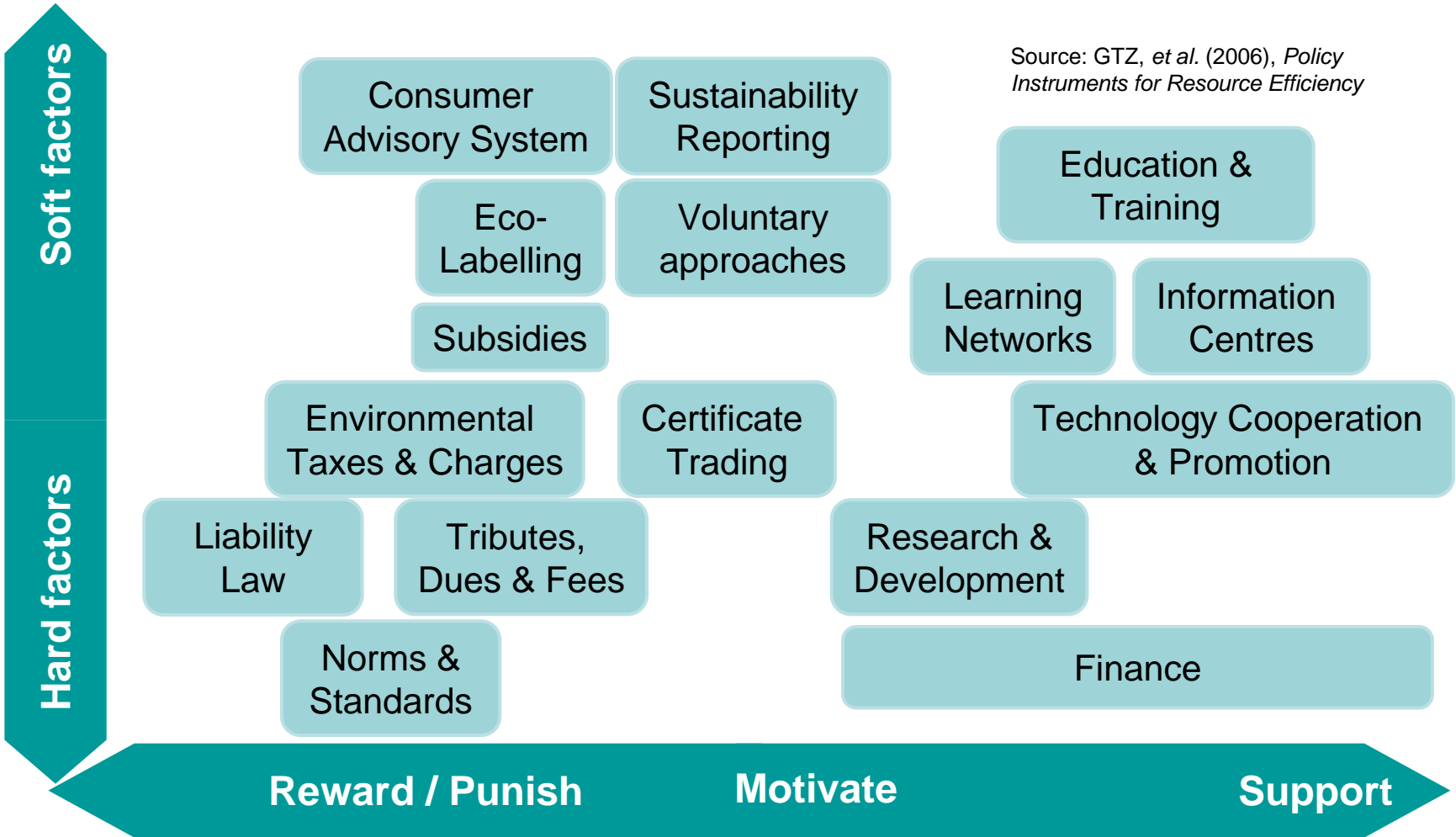

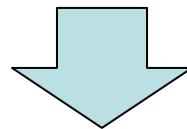
Many governments are shifting their focus from regulations to softer, more collaborative measures
