

## **CZECH REPUBLIC**

### **Sources and definitions**

Data are supplied by the Czech Statistical Office (Český Statistický Úřad). For industry and services statistics, data are derived from a sample survey, the annual structural business survey. Random sampling is used, stratified by size of enterprise and two-digit code of the classification. The survey covers all enterprises which were active at least part of the year irrespective of size. The reference period is the calendar year. The statistical unit is the enterprise.

#### *Variables*

The definition of the variables corresponds to the SSIS definitions, with the following exception: variable total wages and salaries for industry and services sector ISIC 7200 corresponds to personal costs (including payments for insurance).

### **Composition of the ICT sector**

The ICT sector is in line with the OECD definition, but the following industries are not available:

ICT wholesale activities:

NACE 51.43 (Wholesale of electrical household appliances and radio and television goods)

NACE 51.64 (Wholesale of office machinery and equipment)

NACE 51.65 (Wholesale of other machinery for use in industry, trade and navigation)

and

ISIC 7123 (Renting of office machinery & equipment (including computers))
