National accounts

Sources and definitions

Data are supplied by Statistics Netherlands (*Centraal Bureau voor de Statistiek -CBS-*), Voorburg. They originate from the national accounts.

Variables: the definition of the variables corresponds to those used in the national accounts (ESER, SNA).

Production and value added are valued at basic prices.

The number of employed persons and the number of employees are expressed in full-time equivalents (FTEs).

Gross fixed capital formation is valued at purchasing prices, including non-deductible VAT.

Composition of the ICT sector

The ICT sector is in line with the OECD definition, with the following exceptions:

The ISIC Rev.3 class 6420 (Telecommunication) is provided together with ISIC Rev. 3 classes 6411 and 6412, due to confidentiality.

The following industries are not available:

ICT wholesale activities (ISIC Rev.3 class 5150: wholesale of machinery, equipment & supplies)

and

ISIC Rev.3 class 7123 (renting of office machinery and equipment,including computers)
