## Identity and Passport Service (IPS)

- Identity and Passport Service formed on April 1 2006
- An executive agency of the Home Office
- Responsible for government policy on identity
- Responsible for issuing passports and will issue ID cards from 2009/10

### Passports:

- Issue up to 6.5 million passports per year
- National network of offices
- Passport Validation Service (PVS)
- Fingerprint passports 2009



### National Identity Scheme:

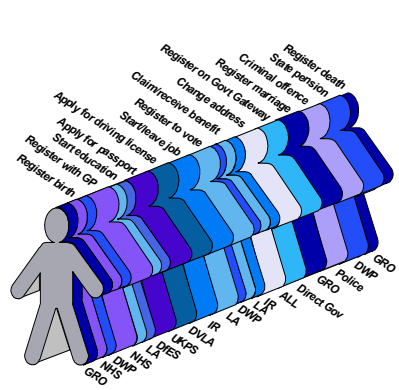
- Partnership with Borders and Immigration Agency, UKvisas and FCO
- Issue ID cards from 2009/10 to UK residents 16 and over
- Provide a National Identity Register (NIR) to store individual records based on biometric data
- Provide identity services

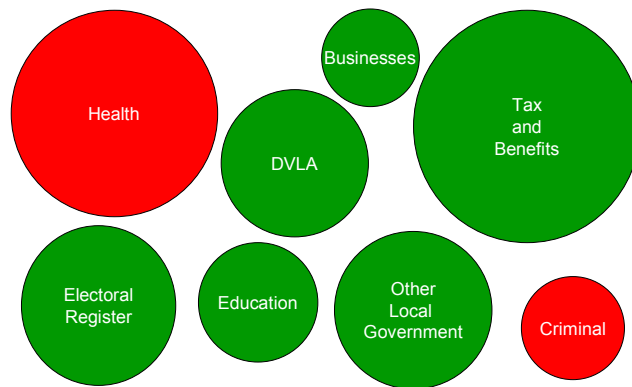

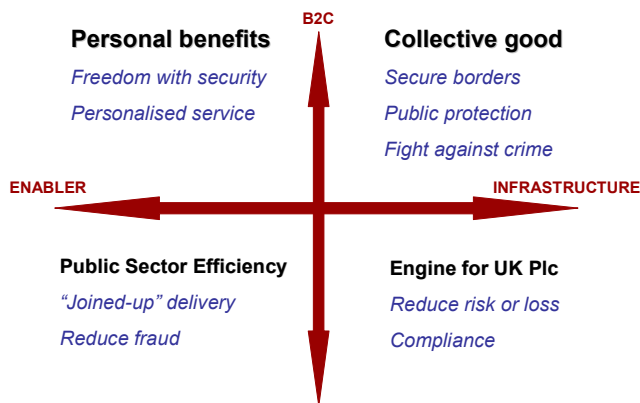

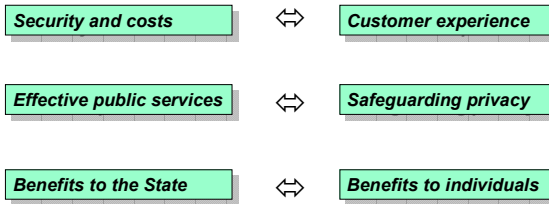
