The Task Force on Tax and Development invites you to attend a one-day conference on the role of tax morale in development.

This event will introduce new research undertaken by the OECD on the drivers of tax morale in developing countries.

Key questions to address:

- How well do we understand tax morale?
- What lessons have we learnt from attempts to build tax morale?
- Is there a role for hypothecation in building tax morale?

- What drives tax morale in businesses?
- How can development partners support building tax morale?
- What is the role of civil society in building tax morale?
