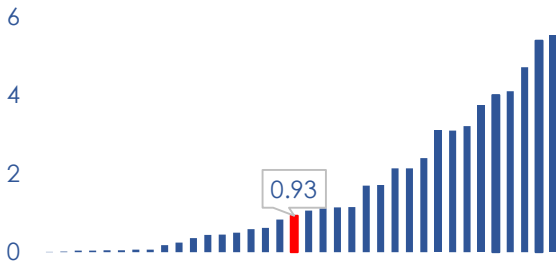

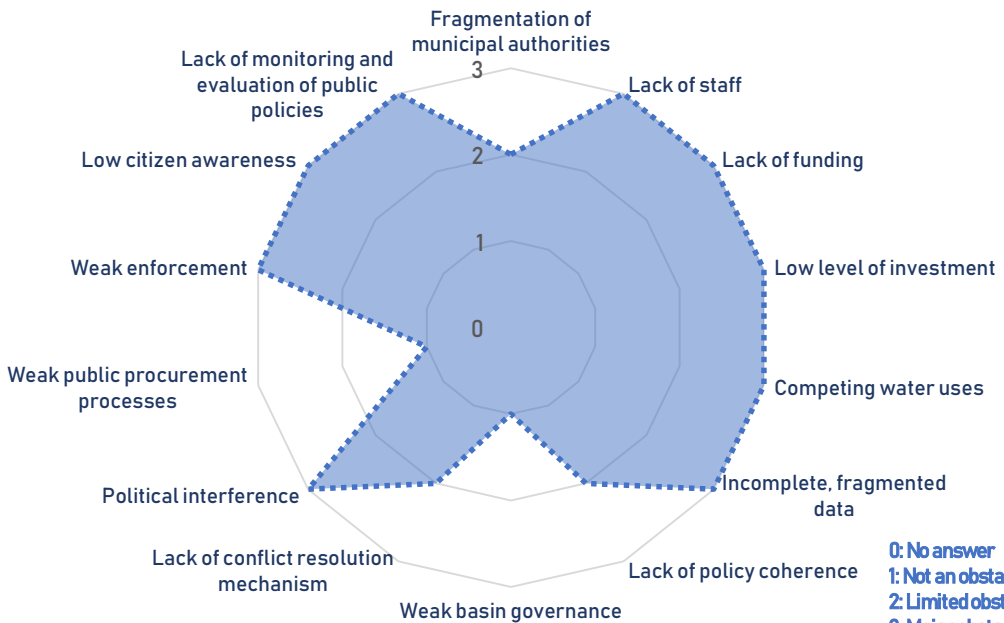

National level

- No recognition of the UN right to Water and Sanitation
