HOW TO REACH BOLZANO



Arriving by plane

Verona

The airport "Valerio Catullo" in Verona is the closest to Bolzano (150km away).

The Verona Airport is connected to the Verona train station – "Verona Porta Nuova" – via a [Shuttle service](#) that runs daily from 5.35 to 8.30 pm every 20 minutes and from 8:30 p.m. to 11:10 p.m. every 40 minutes. A single ride ticket costs 6.00 €.

From Verona train station, Bolzano can be reached in around 2 hours. There are trains every 40 minutes. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Thanks to the new partnership between ATV and [German \(DB\) and Austrian \(ÖBB\) railways](#), all travellers flying to Verona, by purchasing a single cumulative ticket, can use the AEROBUS service from the Catullo Airport to Verona Porta Nuova (or vice versa) to take a train to reach locations in South Tyrol and in Trentino. Fares for the cumulative ticket (train+ATV Aerobus) are 22.00 € for South Tyrol (Bolzano, Bressanone, and Fortezza).

Venice

Venice has two airports: Venezia Marco Polo and Treviso Canova.

[Venezia Marco Polo Airport](#) is 273 km from Bolzano, while the airport [Treviso Canova](#) is located 290 km away from Bolzano. Both airports are connected through the regular bus services to the nearest train stations: Venezia Mestre and Venezia Santa Lucia.

From Venice train stations you can get to Bolzano in 4 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Milano

There are three airports: Milano Malpensa, Milano Linate and Bergamo Orio al Serio.

The nearest train stations to [Milano Malpensa](#) are Milano Cadorna, Milano Centrale and Milano Porta Garibaldi.

[Milano Linate](#) is connected to the city centre via bus or metro.

From Milano train station you can get to Bolzano in 3 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

The Orio al Serio airport in Bergamo is 235 km away from Bolzano, which can be reached in about 3.5 hours by bus, thanks to a direct [FlixBus](#) connection from the airport.

Bologna

The Marconi airport of Bologna is 276 km away from Bolzano. From the airport you can easily reach Bologna Centrale, the main train station, via [Aerobus](#) that runs daily every 11 minutes from 7 am to 9.15 pm and every 30 minutes 5 - 7 am and 9.15 pm – 00.15 am. From Bologna train station you can get to Bolzano in about 3 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

You can also reach Bolzano by [FlixBus](#) buses.

Munich (Germany)

The Munich airport Franz Joseph Strauss is 317 km away from Bolzano. You can get to Bolzano in 3.5 hours by [train](#).

Innsbruck (Austria)

The Innsbruck airport is 122km away from Bolzano. Innsbruck Airport is easily accessed by train or bus. [Bus route F](#) connects Innsbruck main station with the airport main building. The journey takes about 20 minutes. From Innsbruck train station you can get to Bolzano in 2 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Coming from the south

We suggest to take the motorway exit "Bolzano Sud" and to park your car at the Fair (1300 lots). From there you find public busses to the centre every 15 minutes or the train every 30 minutes.

Coming from the north

We suggest to take the motorway exit "Bolzano Nord" and to park at the parking "Bolzano Centro", which is only a few minutes walking from the centre.

Since May 2014 the access to the city centre of Bolzano Bozen is under video surveillance. Please follow the indication to the parking places and do not overstep the gates in order to avoid the sanction.

OECD airport transfers from Milan and Venice

The OECD will organise airport transfers for Milano Linate and Venice Marco Polo airports with the following schedule:

- a. Navette Milan A to Bolzano on 27 March 2019 at 19.00
- b. Navette Milan B to Bolzano on 28 March 2019 at 10.30
- c. Navette Venice C to Bolzano on 27 March 2019 at 19.00
- d. Navette Venice D to Bolzano on 28 March 2019 at 10.30
- e. Navette Bolzano to Milan on 29 March 2019 at 14.00

From Bolzano to Venice on 29 March 2019 a direct train leaving Bolzano at 15.13 and arriving in Venice Mestre at 17.58 is the best option, therefore no transfer will be activated for this route.

Please mark in the registration if you intend to benefit of this facility. The transfers will be activated only with a minimum of 5 participants per single transfer. By 15 March 2019 final confirmation of flight details should be provided to the organisers who will issue a personal voucher accordingly. No personal transfers will be organised.

Milano Malpensa and Milano Linate airports are connected via shuttles. Consult the detailed schedule [here](#).
