Place, dates and times

The Winter School will be held in-person in Trento and Rovereto, Italy and will start on Tuesday 28 February 2023 at 8.30, ending on Thursday 2 March 2023 September 2022 at 13.00. An optional informal meeting with participants to get to know each other will be held on Monday 27 February 2023 at 17.00.

COVID-19

The Winter School will respect all COVID-19-related health guidelines by the Italian authorities. To enter Italy from any country, please consult the [official page of the Italian Ministry of Health](#).

Participation costs

A tuition fee of 250.00 EUR for EURADA members (290.00 EUR for non EURADA members) is foreseen for the Winter School. The organisers will cover transportation costs in Trento as well as lunches and a dinner during the Winter School, whereas accommodation, travel to Trento expenses, medical insurance, entry visa application charges (if required for the specific home country), dinners and other personal expenses not specified in the Winter School agenda, will be borne by selected participants. The modalities of the payment (due on 8 February 2023) will be detailed in the communication of the result of the application.

Visa

Please note that participants are responsible for obtaining their own visa for entering Italy if necessary. Please contact your Ministry of Foreign Affairs if that is the case. The Winter School team is available to support you with an invitation letter if needed. HOW TO REACH TRENTO



Arriving by plane

Verona

The Verona airport "Valerio Catullo" in Verona is the closest to Trento (93 km away).

The Verona Airport is connected to the Verona train station – "Verona Porta Nuova" – via a [Shuttle service](#) that runs daily at 5.35 am, 6.30 am, 6.50 am, 7.10 am then every 20 minutes until 11.30 pm. A single ride ticket costs 6.00 €.

From Verona train station, Trento can be reached in about one hour. Please note that trains are running to Trento till 9.00 pm in the evening. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Thanks to the new partnership between ATV and [German \(DB\) and Austrian \(ÖBB\) railways](#), all travellers flying to Verona, by purchasing a single cumulative ticket, can use the AEROBUS service from the Catullo Airport to Verona Porta Nuova (or vice versa) to take a train to reach locations in South Tyrol and in Trentino. Fares for the cumulative ticket (train+ATV Aerobus) are 18.00 € for Trento.

Venice

Venice has two airports: Venezia Marco Polo and Treviso Canova.

Venezia Marco Polo Airport is 154 km from Trento, while the airport Treviso Canova is located 134 km away from Trento. There is a direct FlixBus line from Venezia Marco Polo Airport to Trento.

Both airports are connected through the regular bus services to the nearest train stations: Venezia Mestre and Venezia Santa Lucia.

From Venice train stations you can get to Trento in 2-3 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Milano

There are three airports: Milano Malpensa, Milano Linate and Bergamo Orio al Serio.

The nearest train stations to Milano Malpensa are Milano Cadorna, Milano Centrale and Milano Porta Garibaldi. From Milano train station you can get to Trento in about 3 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Milano Linate is connected to the city centre via bus or metro. Further information can be found [here](#). There is a direct FlixBus line from Milano Linate airport to Trento.

The Orio al Serio airport in Bergamo is 194 km away from Trento, which can be reached in about 2-3 hours by bus, thanks to a direct FlixBus connection from the airport:

Bologna

The Marconi airport of Bologna is 226 km away from Trento. From the airport you can easily reach Bologna Centrale, the main train station, via Aerobus that runs daily every 11 minutes from 5:30 am to 12:15 am. From Bologna train station you can get to Trento in about 2 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).

Munich (Germany)

The Munich airport Franz Joseph Strauss is 355 km away from Trento. You can get to Trento from the Munich Central Train Station by train or by FlixBus. The Munich Central Station can be reached by bus or S-Bahn. The FlixBus stop, which is 1 km away from the Munich Central Train Station, is closest to the Munchen Hackerbrücke station (connected to the Munich Airport by line S8 of the S-Bahn).

Innsbruck (Austria)

The Innsbruck airport is 185km away from Trento.

Innsbruck Airport is easily accessed by train or bus. Bus route F connects Innsbruck main station with the airport main building. The journey takes about 20 minutes.

From Innsbruck train station you can get to Trento in 3 hours. Check the trains schedule [here](#).
