

Bio: David McLennan

David McLennan is a Senior Research Fellow at the Department of Social Policy and Intervention at the University of Oxford. He is Deputy Director of Centre for the Analysis of South African Social Policy (CASASP). His primary research interest is in the spatial distribution of poverty and deprivation at small area level (i.e. neighbourhood level), with a particular focus on South Africa, southern Africa more broadly, and the United Kingdom. Current major research projects include: *The Economic Deprivation Index 1999-2009* for the UK Department for Communities and Local Government; *The relationship between spatial inequality and attitudes to inequality in South Africa* for the UK Economic and Social Research Council; and *Crime, Deprivation and Inequality in South Africa* funded by Oxford University's John Fell Fund.
