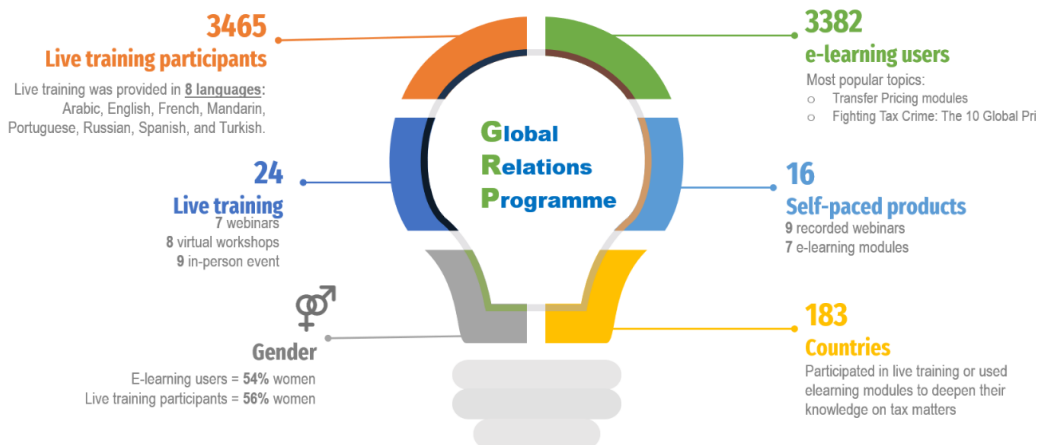

GRP ACTIVITY SUMMARY JANUARY – JUNE 2023

In 2023, GRP has to date welcomed more than **3 400 participants** to its **live training events: 15 virtual and 9 in-person** events co-organised with the Multilateral Tax Centres (MTCs) and partner organisations. In addition, more than **3 300 tax officials** have used the GRP’s self-paced tools. These self-paced tools include **9 recorded webinars and 7 e-learning modules** newly released in 2023.

In the second half of 2023 we look forward to delivering over **20** live events, including in-person workshops in Türkiye and Korea. GRP also plans to release additional recorded webinars and e-learning modules.
