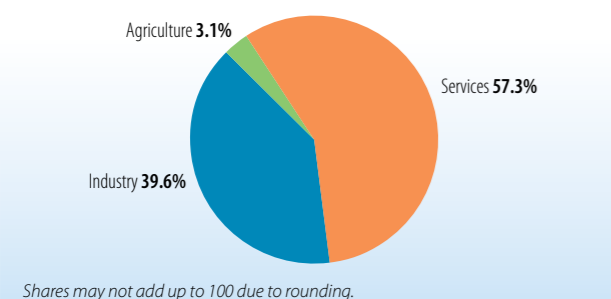


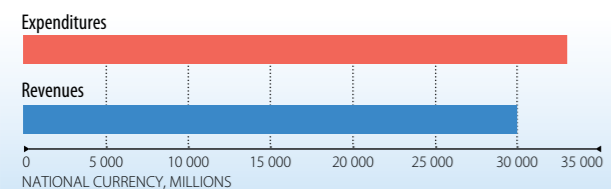

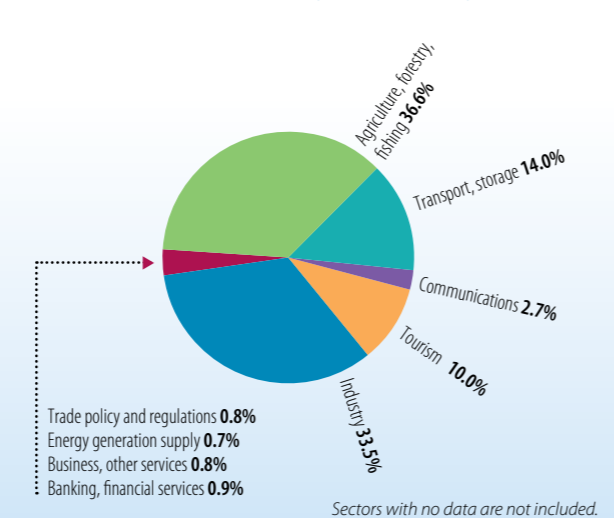

BY SECTOR (Share in total AFT, commitments, 2009)



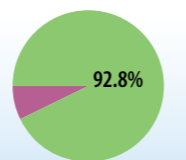
SHARE IN ODA (Commitments, 2008-09 avg.)

AFT share in sector allocable ODA compared to its region and income group shares

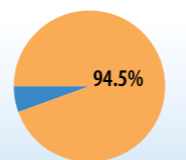

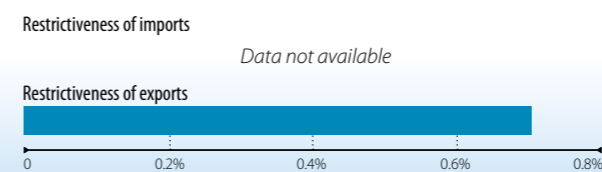

TRADE MAINSTREAMING¹⁴

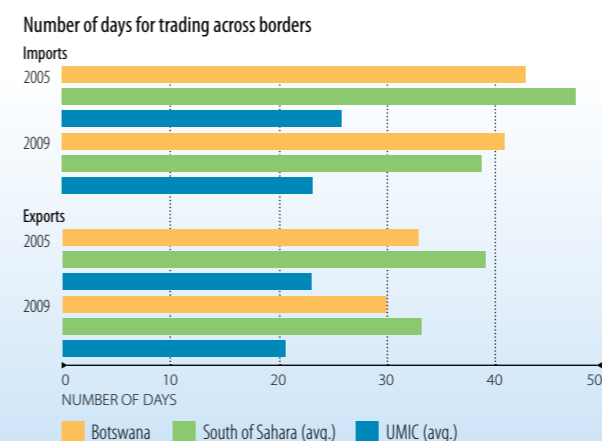
Changes to aid-for-trade priorities have been mainstreamed in the national development plan and the country is planning to update its operational strategies accordingly.

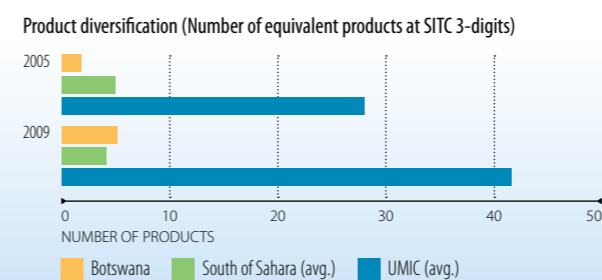

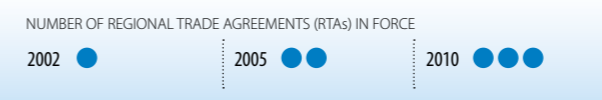
PRIORITY 1: TRADE FACILITATION¹⁶



PRIORITY 2: EXPORT DIVERSIFICATION¹⁷



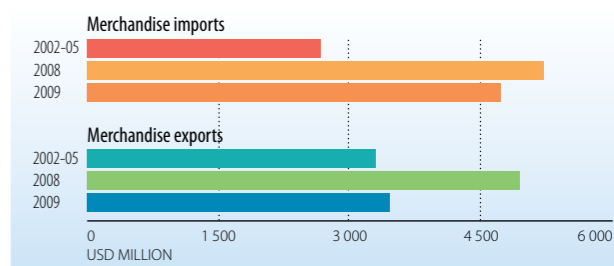

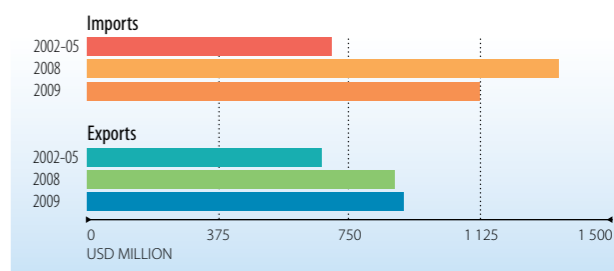

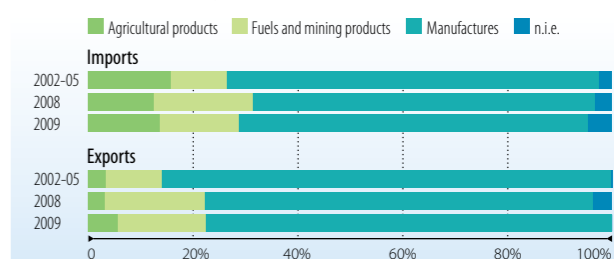
