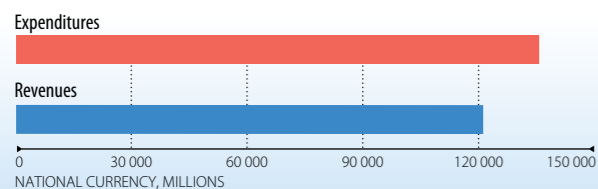

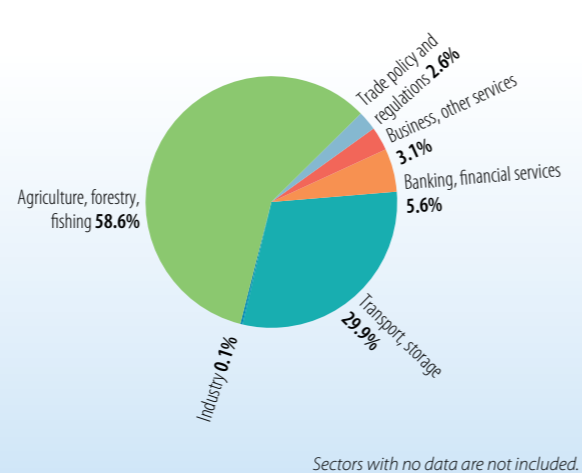

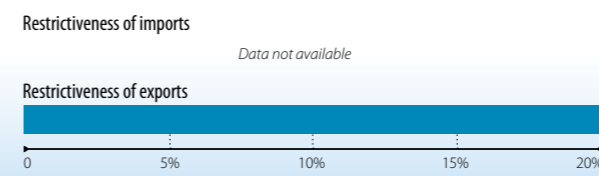

Aid-for-trade priorities remain unchanged.

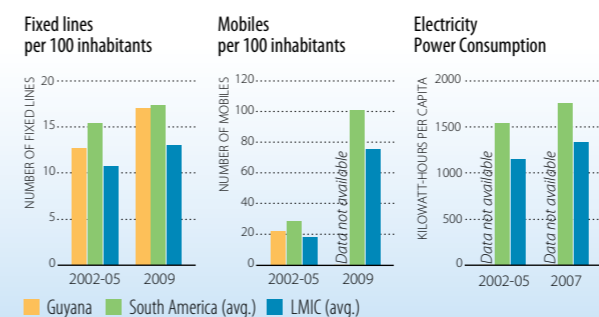
Trade is fully mainstreamed in the national development plan.

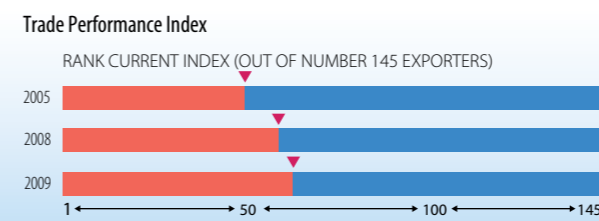

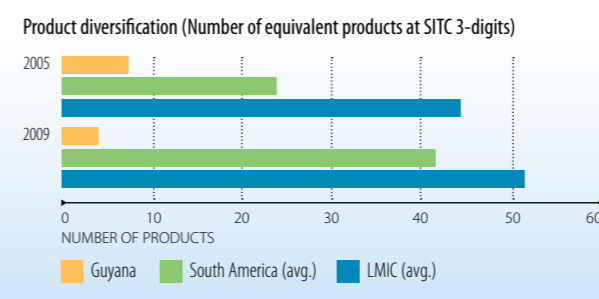
#### PRIORITY 1: NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE<sup>16</sup>



#### PRIORITY 2: COMPETITIVENESS<sup>17</sup>



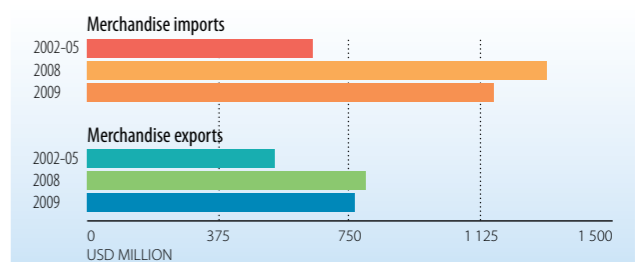

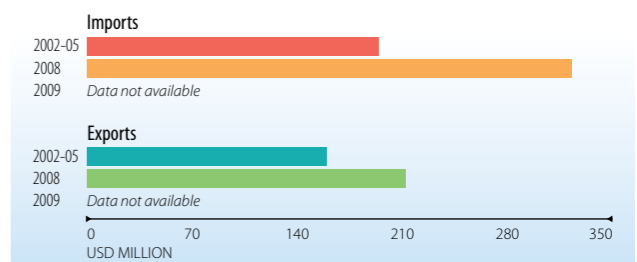

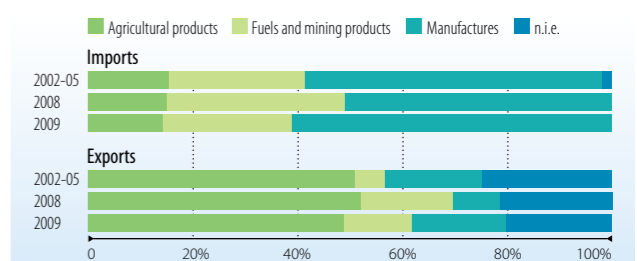
