

ANNEX — YOUR CREDITOR REPORTING SYSTEM (CRS) PROFILE

The OECD Creditor Reporting System (CRS) can be used to track proxies of Aid-for-Trade volumes based on the WTO Task Force definition. These proxies are covered by the CRS under four headings: (1) trade policy and regulations; (2) economic infrastructure (energy, transport & telecoms); (3) building productive capacity; and (4) general budget support (which includes support for trade-related structural adjustment, as well as general programme assistance). Note that the CRS does not have a proxy for the WTO category “other trade-related needs”.
