Objective:	Strengthen the managerial, technical and operational capabilities of the comprehensive action against antipersonnel mines (AICMA) sector in Colombia at the national and regional levels, through technical training and exchange of best practices with the Cambodian Mine Action Center – CMAC.
Description of activities related to the case story topic:	Humanitarian mine action started in Colombia in 2017, but JICA is deepening ties between Colombia and Cambodia and supporting peace and stability together with CMAC, so that people can live without fear of being injured by a landmine and live securely on safe land. Both Colombia and Cambodia face the challenge of demining their national territories in post-conflict scenarios. Indeed, Cambodia has gained a wide experience in the implementation of the different components included in the AICMA sector (such as humanitarian demining, mine risk education, national standards and comprehensive assistance to victims). This project includes the design and implement of a training program for AICMA that will consist of (7) courses and (2) seminars for exchanging knowledge and experiences in demining with Cambodia.
