Professor Erwann Michel-Kerjan serves as Chairman of the OECD Secretary-General High Level Advisory Board on Financial Management of Large-scale Catastrophes. He teaches at the Wharton Business School (Philadelphia, USA) and is Managing Director of the Wharton Risk Management and Decision Processes Center, a Center leader in catastrophe management for the past 25 years. His work focuses on developing strategies and policies for managing and financing extreme events and he advises top decision-makers in governments, corporations and international organizations around the world on these emerging issues.

Dr. Michel-Kerjan has authored or co-authored more than 50 publications at the crux of financial management and global risks governance, and his views regularly appear in leading media. His most recent books are *At War with the Weather* (with H. Kunreuther, MIT Press, 2009) and *The Irrational Economist: Making Decisions in a Dangerous World* (with P. Slovic, 2009). In 2007, Dr. Michel-Kerjan was named a Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum (Davos), a five-year nomination bestowed to recognize and acknowledge the most extraordinary leaders of the world under the age of 40.
