



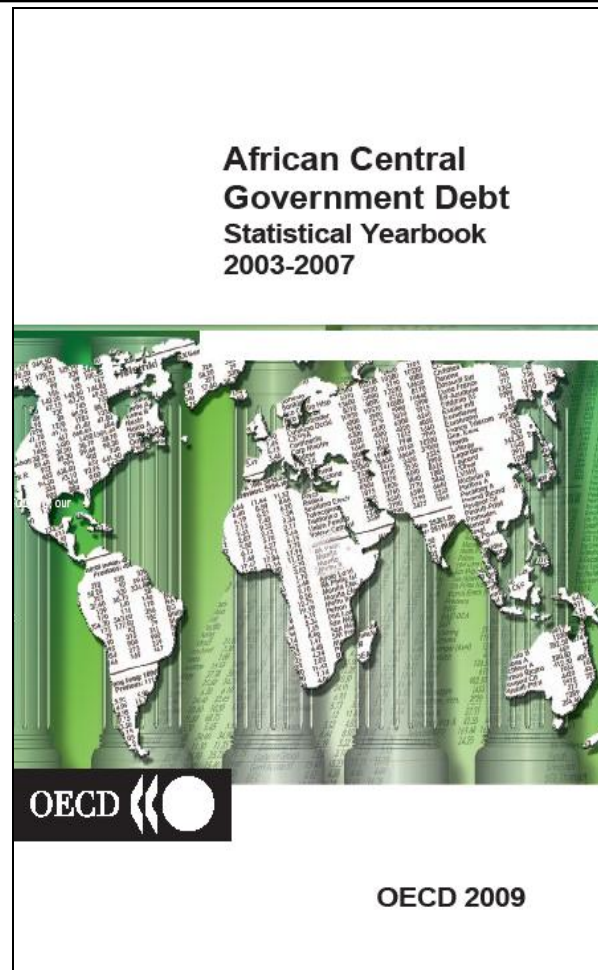

The Yearbook, 5 data sets

- The debt stock
- Accumulations/decumulations of debt
- Term to maturity & Refixing
- Ownership of local currency marketable debt
- Interest rates (YTM) for 16 different maturities, 4-ST, 6-MT and 6-LT

The Yearbook, policy notes

Policy notes include:

- General description of the country's debt management policies.
- Description of all debt instruments.
- Description selling techniques.
- Description of primary and secondary bond market structure and activities.

The Yearbook, Pan-African comparisons

- 6 charts comparing:
 - Central Government Debt, in million Euro 's
 - Central Government Debt, as % of GDP
 - Central Govt. Marketable Debt, as % of GDP
 - Central Govt. Non-Market. Debt, as % of GDP
 - Central Govt. Marketable Debt, as % of GDP
 - Central Govt. Marketable and Non-Marketable Debt as % of total.
 - Average term to maturity of total debt.
