Proximity/Relationship to Conflict = Added Scrutiny

Proximity/Relationship	Level	Scrutiny
Not near conflict	1	Normal
Countries of + Concern	2A	Higher
OECD Red Flag Countries	2B	Higher
Conflict/DRC	3	Highest
