

## **John Pyne**

Senior Regulator – Financial Regulator (Ireland)

John Pyne has worked for the Central Bank and Financial Services Authority of Ireland since the early 1980s. Within the area of financial sector regulation he has previously been involved in the regulation and supervision of investment and insurance intermediaries, and in the development of the Financial Regulator's Code of Conduct, which applies to all regulated firms (banks, insurers, intermediaries & credit unions etc.).

His principal work areas at present relate to the themes of:

- competition and consumer welfare;
- market transparency; and
- the evolution of the EU regulatory agenda (particularly as it affects financial consumers).

He is a member of the Committee of European Securities Regulator's economist network, working in particular on the development of that organisation's Regulatory Impact Assessment (RIA) model. He is also Acting Secretary of the International Forum on Financial Consumer Education and Protection.

John is also currently overseeing the final stages of the Financial Regulator's first Financial Capability study.
