

## George Kopits

George Kopits is a senior scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars. He is also a member of Portugal's Public Finance Council and a member of the Commission on Reform of the Macro-Fiscal Framework in Peru.

In 2009-11, Kopits served as the first chair of the Fiscal Council in Hungary—elected unanimously by Parliament. In 2004-09, he was a member of the Monetary Council, National Bank of Hungary. Previous positions include assistant director at the Fiscal Affairs Department, International Monetary Fund, and financial economist at the Office of the Secretary, U.S. Treasury Department. He has given technical advice on various policy issues to governments in Europe, Latin America, Africa, and Asia.

He is the author of more than sixty publications. He has held visiting academic appointments at Bocconi, Budapest, Cape Town, Johns Hopkins, Siena, and Vienna universities. Currently, he is on the adjunct faculty of the Central European University, and is editing a volume on *Restoring Public Debt Sustainability: the Role of Independent Fiscal Institutions*, to be published in 2013 by Oxford University Press.

Kopits holds a Ph.D. in economics from Georgetown University and is a member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
