Location:

The meeting will be held in the [Nordic Hotel Forum](#), Viru väljak 3, 10111 Tallinn. The hotel is located in the very city centre, just 150 metres from the Old Town.

Accommodation:

For your convenience, we recommend staying in the Nordic Hotel Forum, where the meeting takes place. The OECD-rate (incl. breakfast, Wi-Fi and use of leisure centre) is 95 € (standard room, single/double) or 115€ (business class room, single/double).

Travel to Estonia:

Arriving by plane

Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport is very close to the city centre/hotel – only 10 minutes' drive away (c.a. 4 km) and about 15 minutes by public transport.

- **Bus No. 2** leaves from the airport to the city centre and port every 20-30 minutes, and operates from 6.00 a.m. until midnight. Tickets can be bought from the driver (1.6 €). Disembark at the “A. Laikmaa” stop which is located next to the Original Sokos Hotel Viru.

- The most convenient way to get from the airport to the hotel is by taxi. Estimated cost of a ride to the city centre is 7-8 €. Taxi stand is located right in front of the airport: [choose a taxi](#) with a clear logo on the side. According to Estonian law, taxis are required to publish their full price list on the passenger's side of the window and all customers are allowed to choose which ever taxi they prefer, regardless of their position in the line.

Arriving by ferry

The [Port of Tallinn](#) is only 10 minutes' walk from the Old Town and city centre.

- **Helsinki** port in Finland is 80km from Tallinn and it takes less than 2 hours on a ferry.
- **Stockholm** ports in Sweden are 380km from Tallinn and boat travels once a day in both directions (you spend the night at sea).

Public transportation in Tallinn

Central Tallinn is very compact and easy to get around. To reach the suburbs there are buses, trolley buses and tram-lines in place. Public transport operates between 6:00 and 23:00 (some lines operate until 24:00). Tallinn uses plastic smartcard and e-ticket system as of January 1, 2013. You can still buy single journey regular paper tickets costing 1.60 Euros from the driver when entering public transportation. Please try to have precise change for the driver if you want to buy a ticket.

Taxi

Cost of taxi is approximately 0.55 EUR /per kilometre + starting fare 2.88 EUR. Most of the taxis do not accept payments by card.

The taxi fares may slightly vary depending on the traffic and company. Please note that most of the taxis accept only cash payments, therefore you should change some money in advance, or do it at the currency exchange points (there are exchange points at the airport and at the port).
