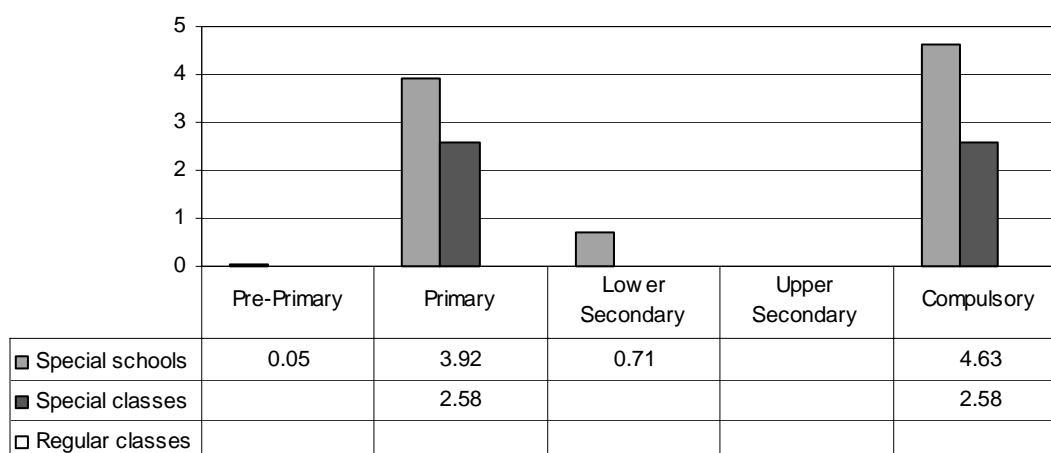


## HUNGARY

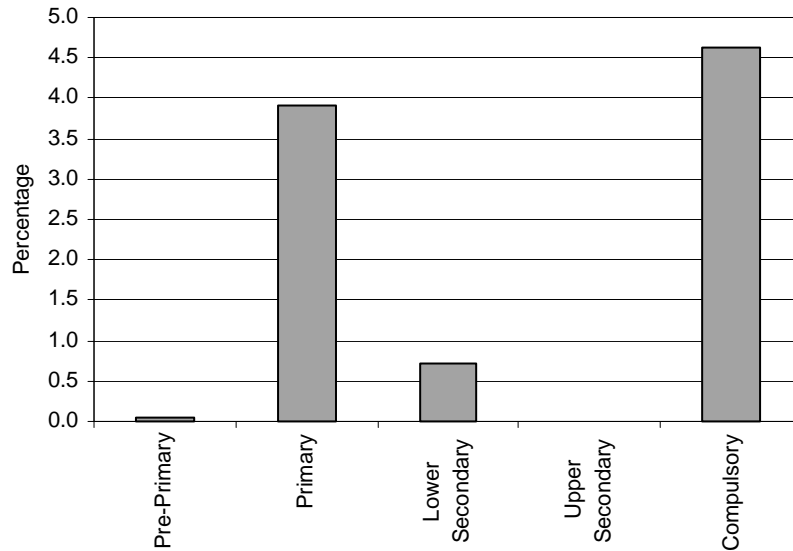
*Category 1 Cross-national Category B* - Slight cognitive dysfunction based on impairment of the brain. Definition according to the law. This group belongs to the IQ range 51-70. Many pupils, who were classified as mild mentally retarded, have no brain impairment and therefore could be classified as learning disabled like in many other countries but actually the law of public education does not use the label of learning disability. These are not mentally-retarded pupils but learning disabled pupils who would belong to the cross-national category B and not category A.

### Proportion of students with mild degree mental retardation by phases of education in special schools, special classes and regular classes



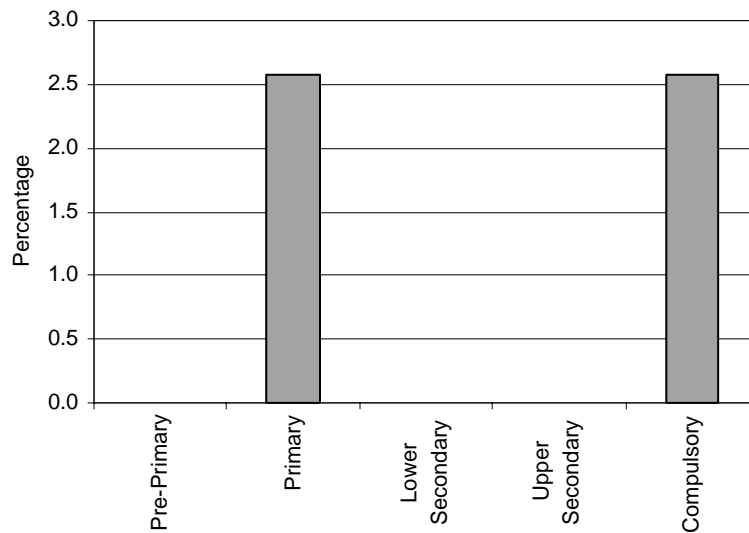

**Special Classes - Category 1. Total percentage of pupils with mild degree mental retardation falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**

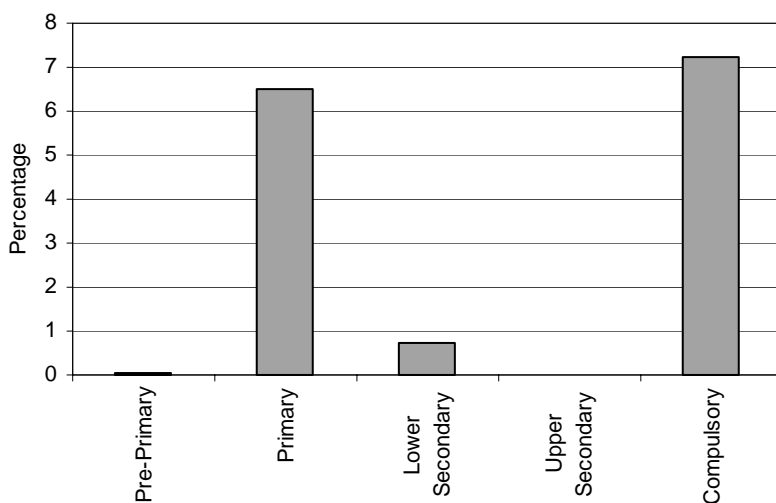

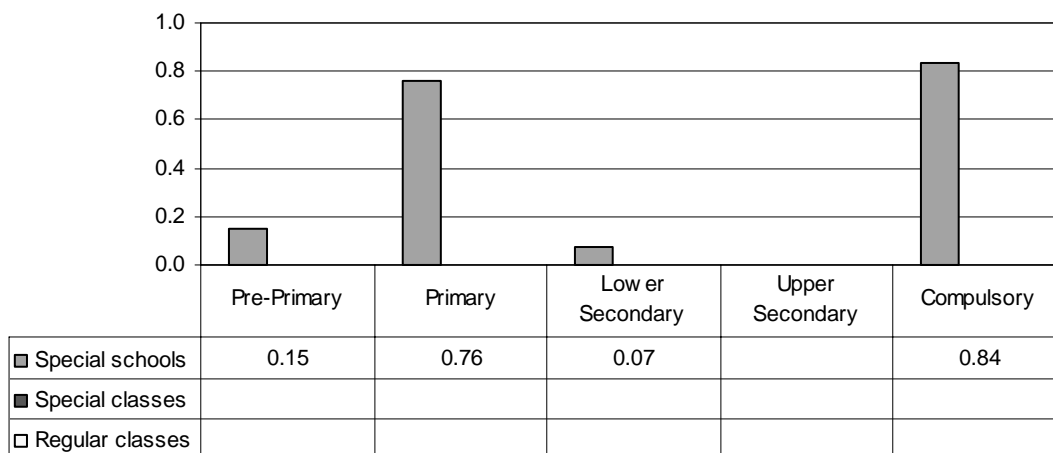

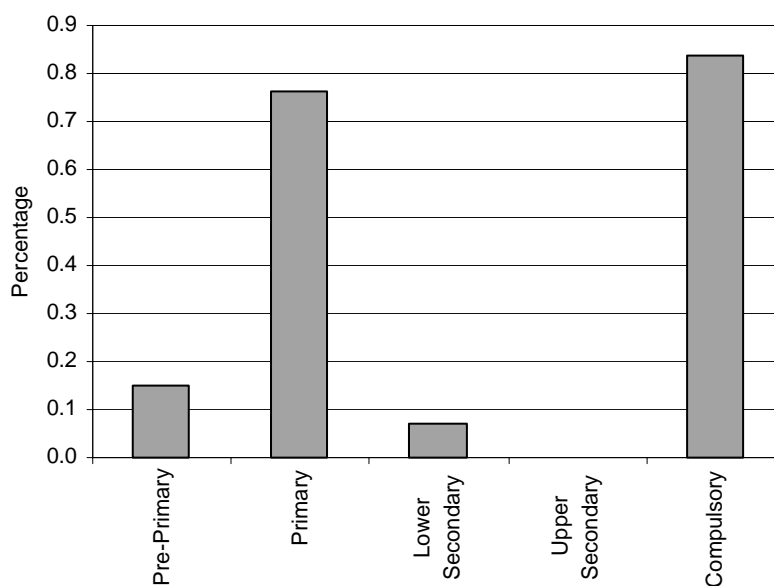
*Category 2 Cross-national Category A - Severe cognitive dysfunction based on impairment of the brain. This group falls into the IQ range 30-50.*

**Special Schools - Category 2. Total percentage of pupils with moderate degree mental retardation falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**

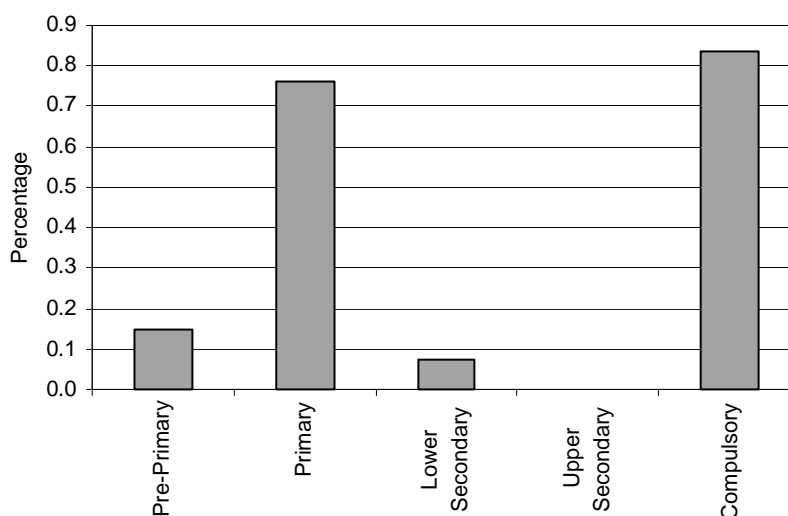

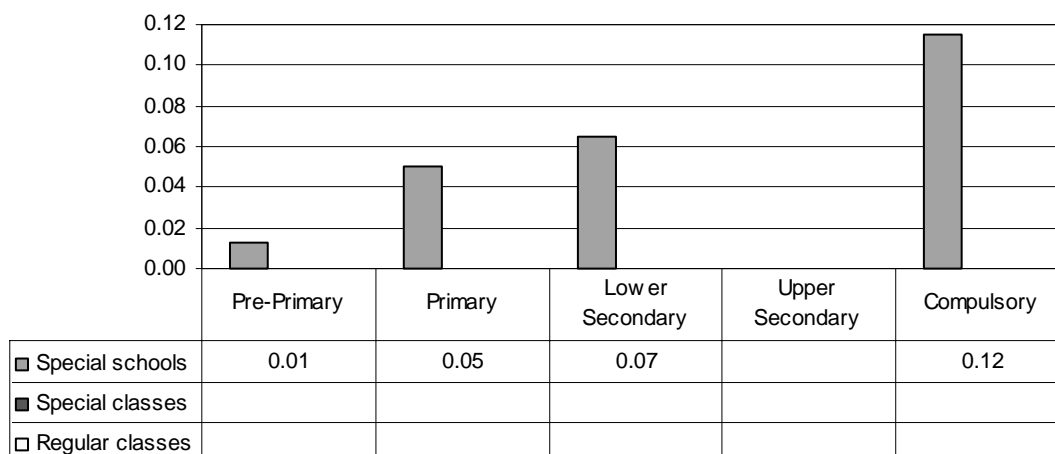

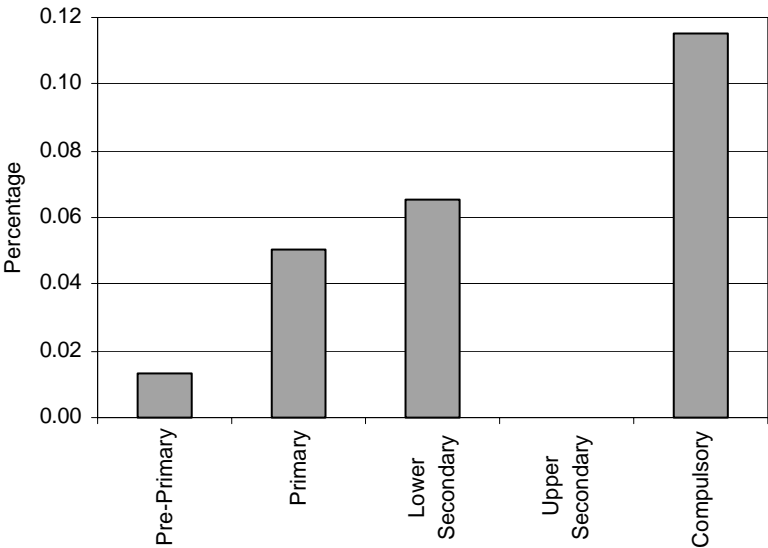
*Category 3 Cross-national Category A - Blindness or low vision based on impairment of the biological visual organs.*

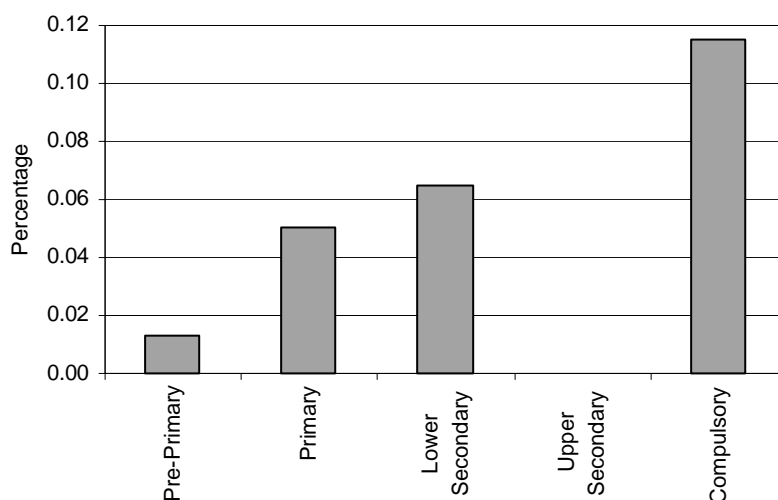

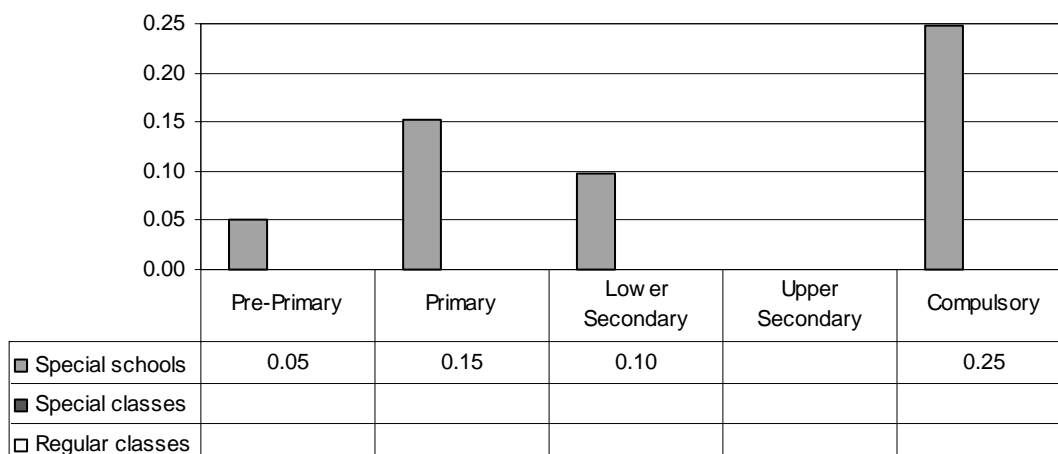

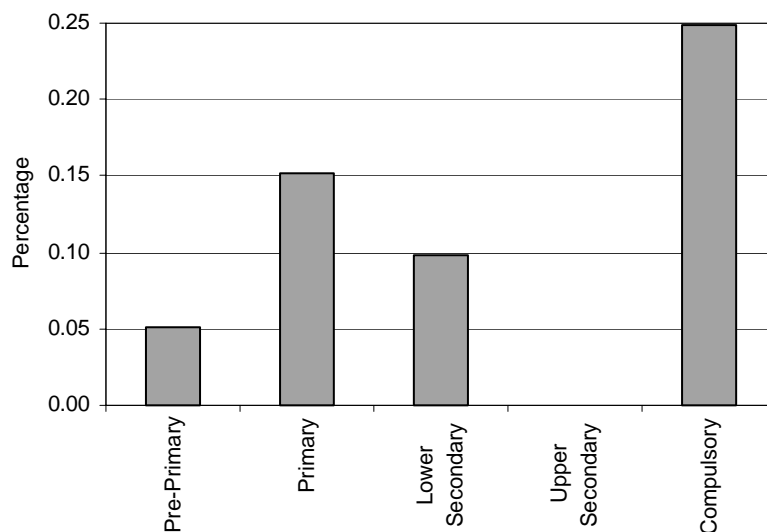

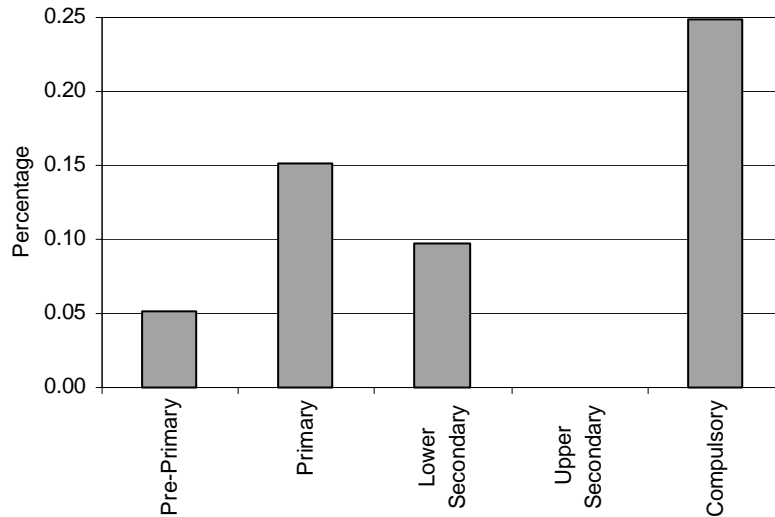

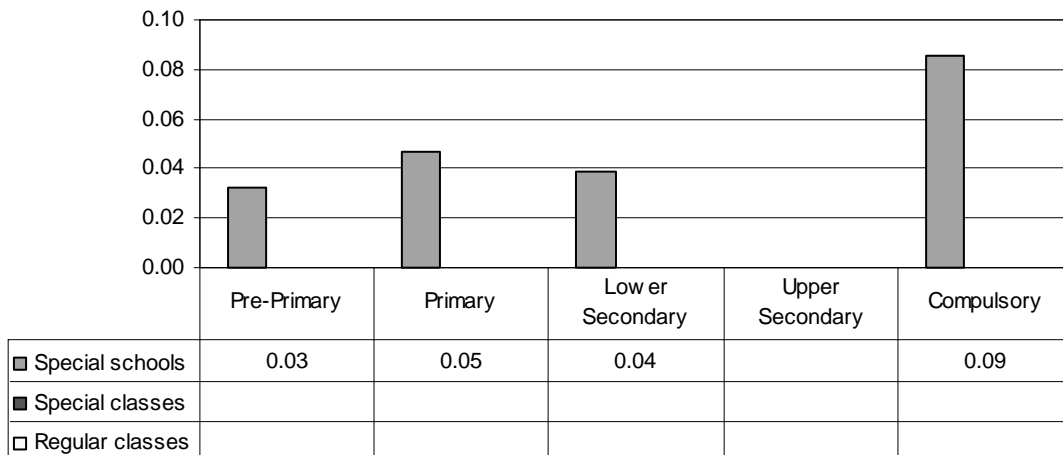

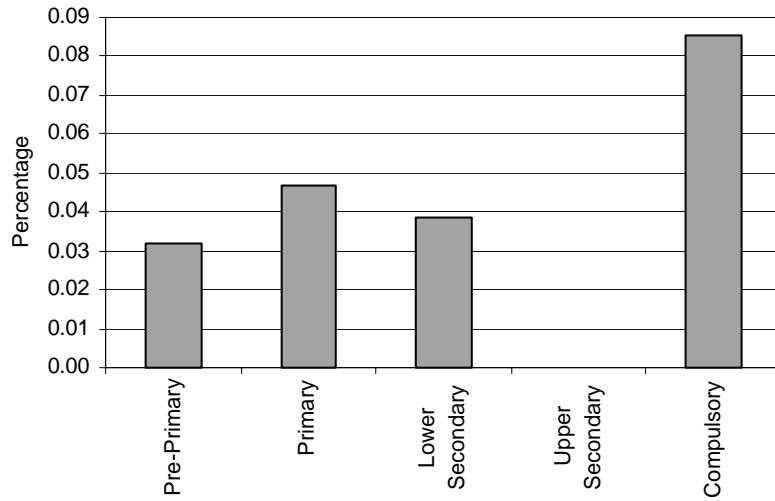
*Category 5 Cross-national Category A - Various forms of motor dysfunction based on impairment of organs of movement.*

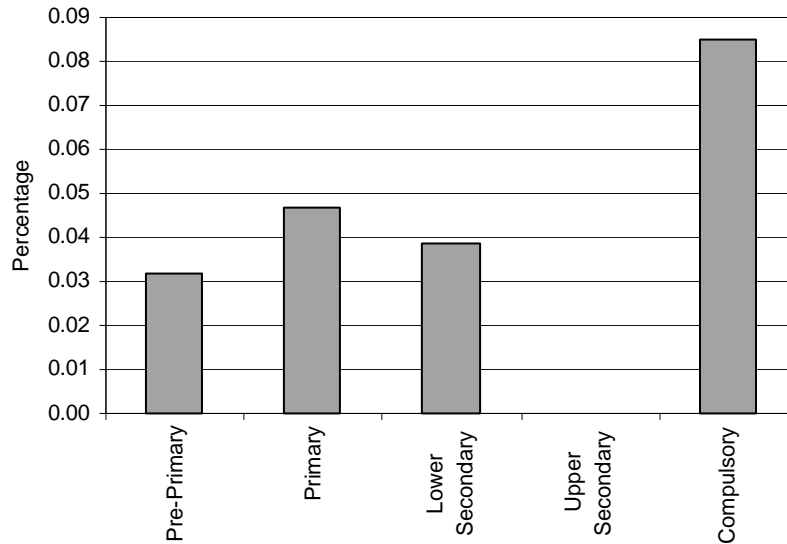

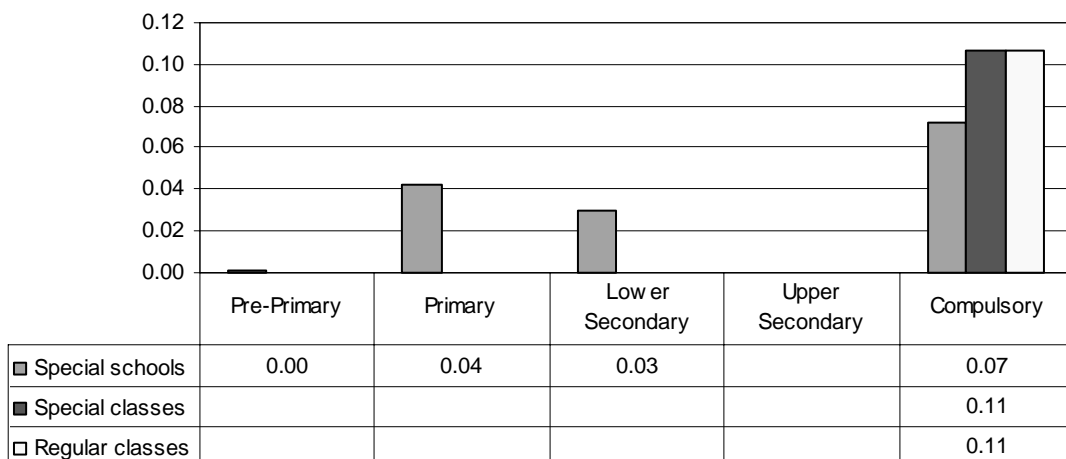

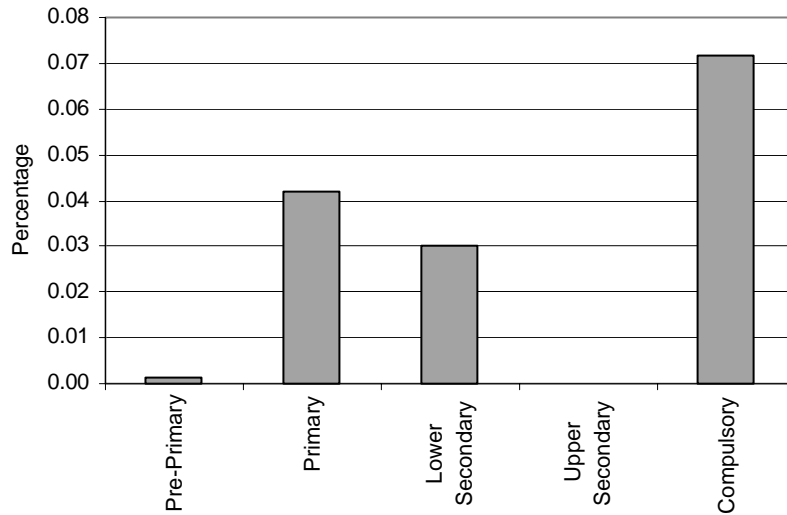
*Category 6 Cross-national Category A - Various forms of speech disorders based on impairment of the speech organs or based on the slow development of language.*

**Proportion of students with speech disabilities by phases of education in special schools, special classes and regular classes**



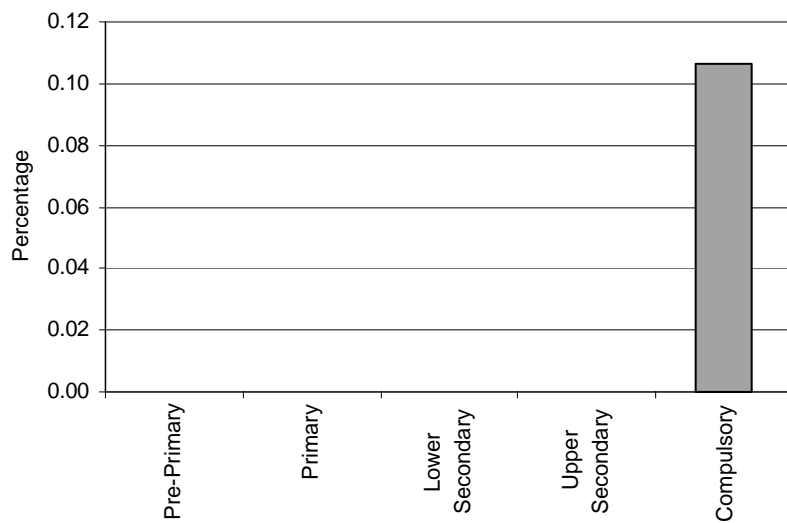

**Special Schools - Category 6. Total percentage of pupils with speech disabilities falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**



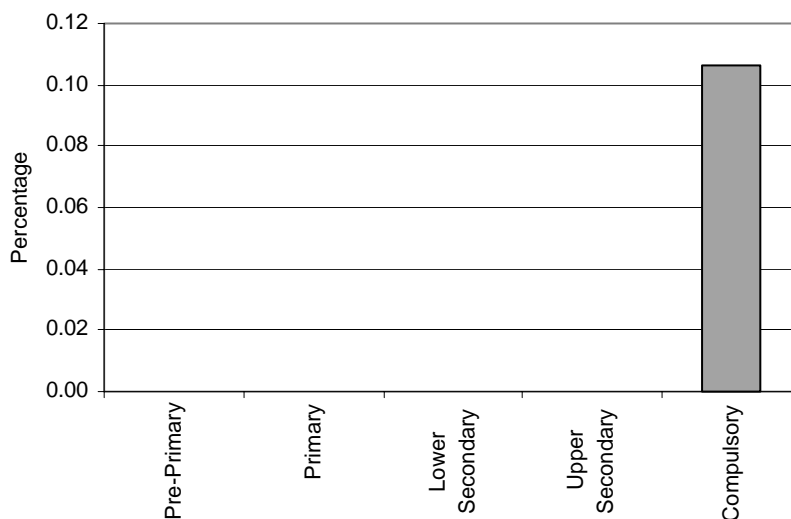

**Special Classes - Category 6. Total percentage of pupils with speech disabilities falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**



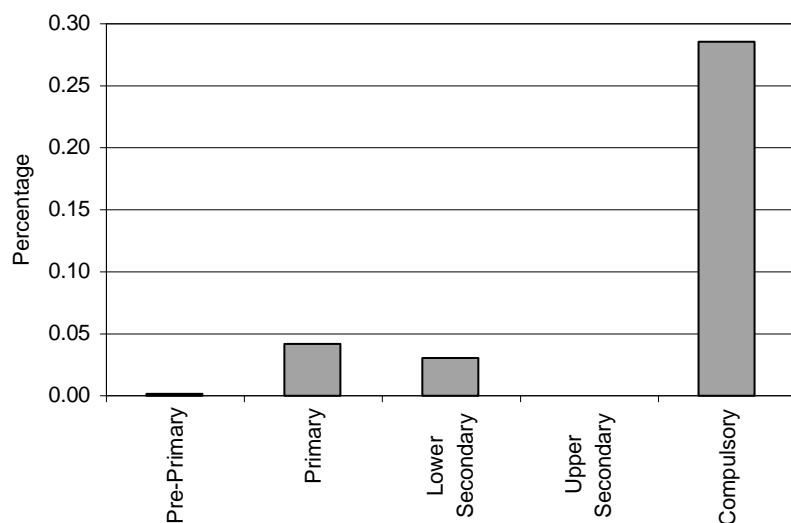

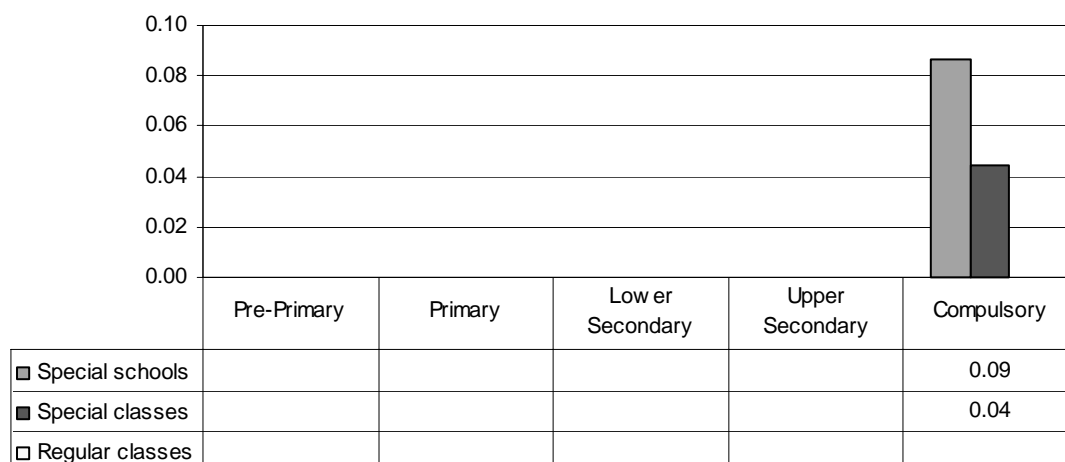

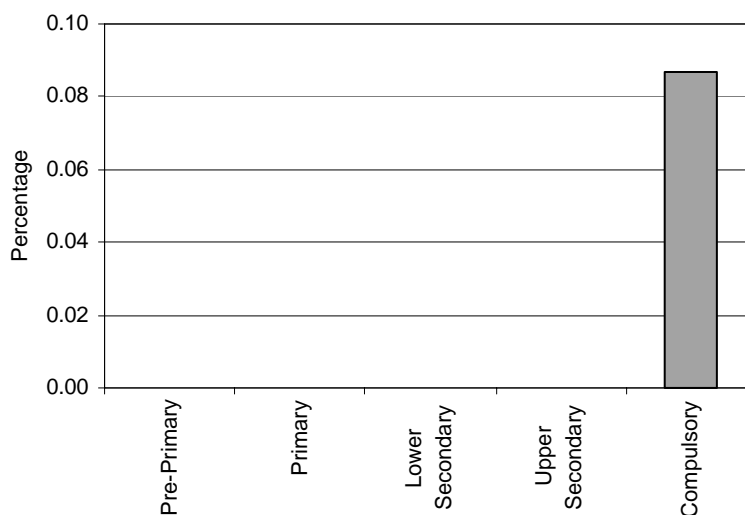

**Proportion of students with other disabilities by phases of education in special schools, special classes and regular classes**



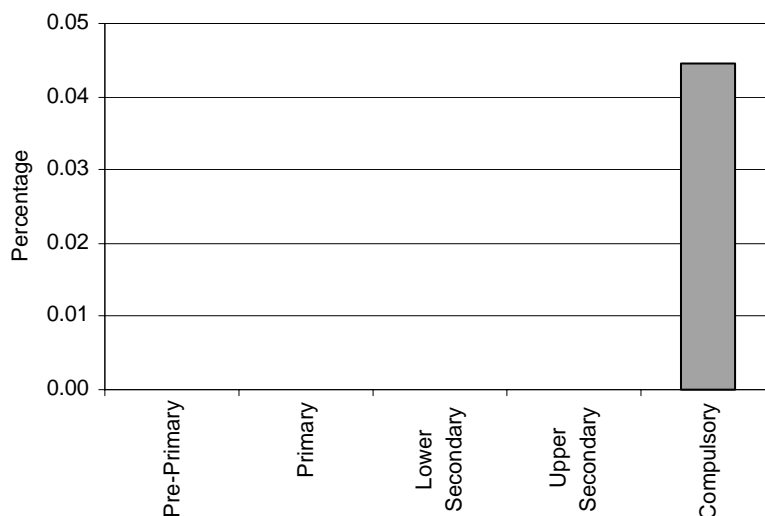

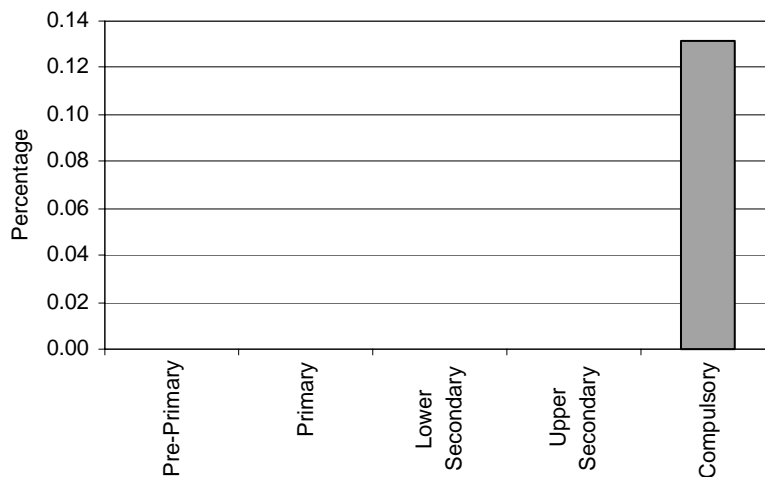
**Special Classes - Category 7. Total percentage of pupils with other disabilities falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**

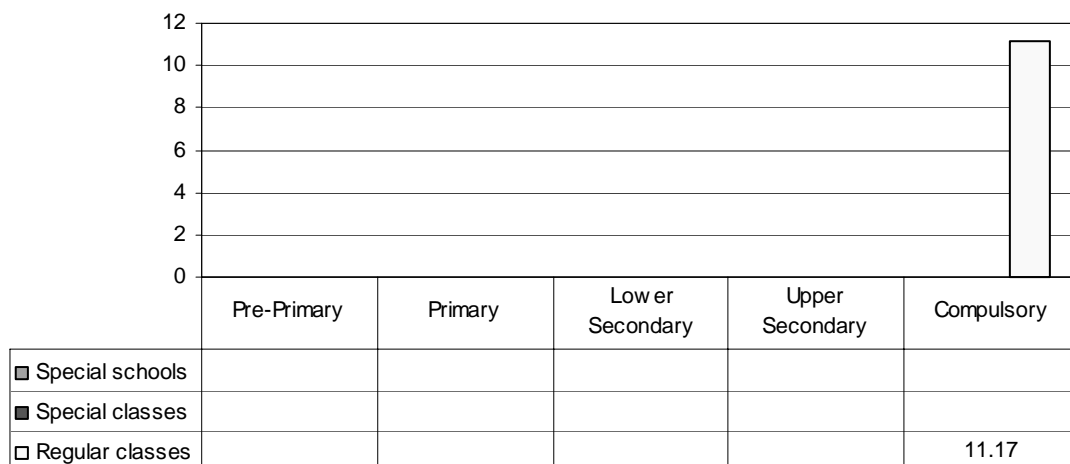

**Proportion of students of minorities by phases of education in special schools, special classes and regular classes**



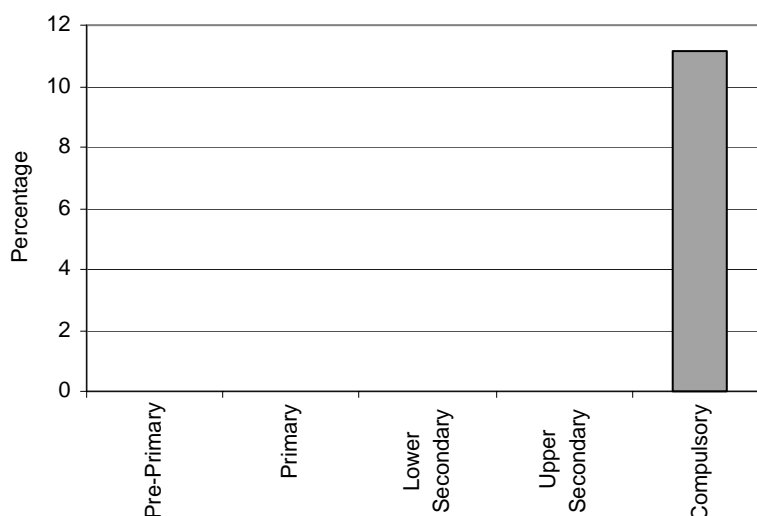

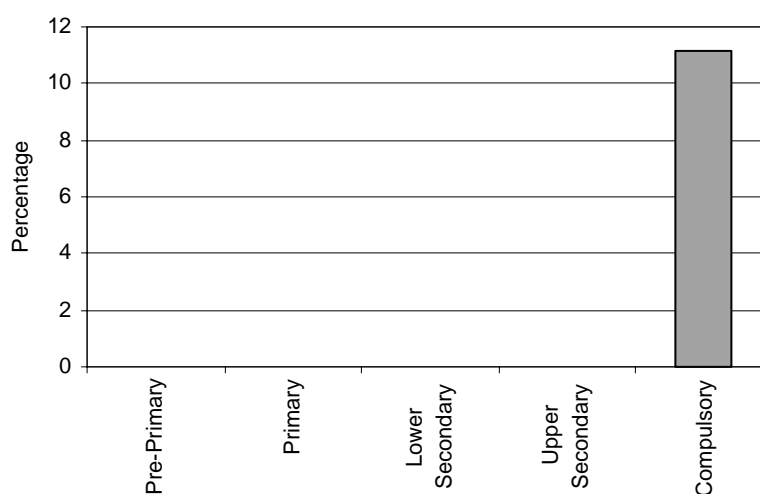


**Regular Classes - Category 8. Total percentage of children of minorities falling within the resources definition, by phase of education**

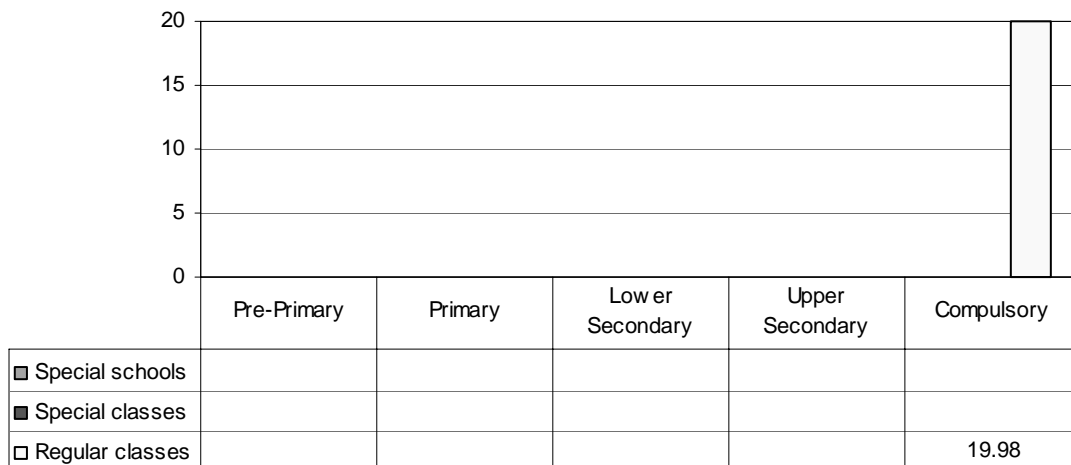

The law, however, ensures them additional resources, but less than for the children with special educational needs.*

**Proportion of disadvantaged students at risk by phases of education in special schools, special classes and regular classes**

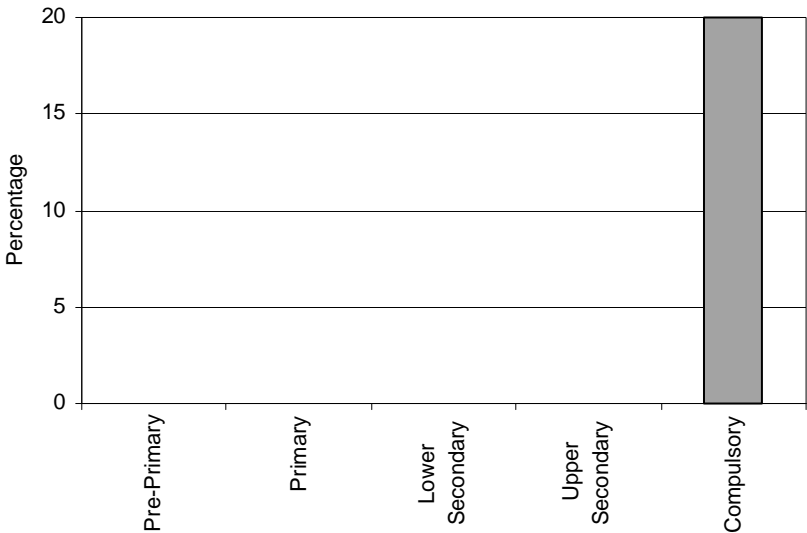

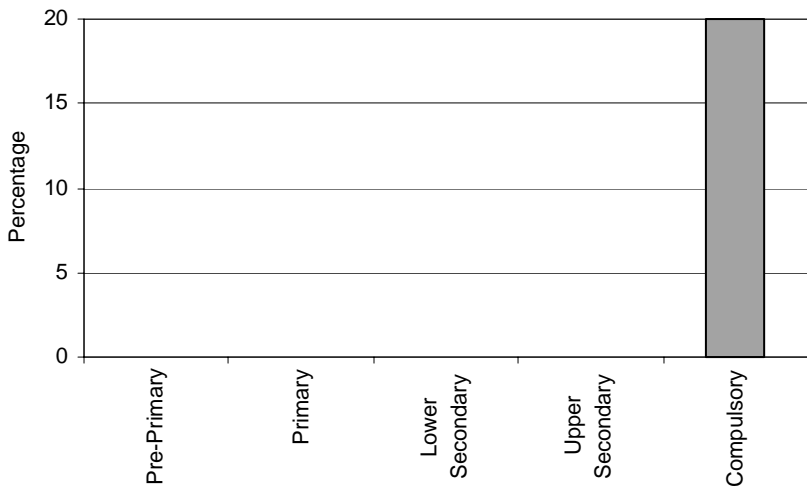
