Airport transportation	There are two airports in the Paris area. North of Paris is <b>Paris Charles de Gaulle</b> (Paris CDG) airport, the largest airport and most often used for international flights. South of Paris is <b>Paris-Orly</b> airport. RATP has 3 dedicated bus lines for travel to and from the major airports around Paris: Orly et Roissy Charles de Gaulle.
